The course will provide Sea Scouts, Venturers, Scouters, and Commissioners that successfully complete course requirements with recognition as a Leave No Trace Instructor (Level 1) in the BSA/Scouting America and the Leave No Trace organizations.

Participants need to bring camping equipment, Annual Health and Medical Record (AHMR, Parts A, B1, and B2), and note-taking materials. Meals and course materials are included in the registration fee.
