## Dependent Care Flexible Spending Account

**You can use your dependent care flexible spending account to help pay for summer day camp fee!**

Planning summertime day care can be stressful - especially if your sitter gets sick, or your nursery closes temporarily because of staffing issues.

While you may not have been thinking about s'mores when you enrolled in your Dependent Care FSA, you can relieve some of the stress of paying for **Cub Scout Day Camp** by using pre-tax money from your flexible spending account! Dependent Care FSA can be used for summer day camp while you work, look for work, or attend school. You can use the funds for your eligible dependents. You will be required to pay out of pocket, then once your child attends Day Camp you can submit a claim for reimbursement.

Overnight camps (Resident Camps) don't qualify for reimbursement. Reason being, the cost of overnight camp isn't considered work-related (like day camp) and thus not applicable.



Consult your tax advisor if you have questions regarding reimbursement under this program.

# Scouts BSA Resident Camp

**Grades:** Entering grades 6-12

**Dates:** June 18 - 24, 2023  
June 25 - July 1, 2023

**Fee:** Early Bird Registration \$330  
Regular Registration \$350  
Late Registration \$375

First two leaders free; additional leaders \$20/day \$100/week



Often described as the pinnacle of the Scouting year, resident summer camp provides multiple opportunities to earn merit badges, learn in the outdoors, bond with fellow Scouts, and HAVE FUN. Multiple programs and merit badges and programs are available during summer camp.

# *NYLT - National Youth Leadership Training*

**Age:** Be at least 14 but not yet 18 years of age

**Dates:** June 11 - 17, 2023

**Fee:** Early Bird Registration \$235  
Regular Registration \$265



All units may send 2 Scouts. Units with 30 or more Scouts may send 3 to NYLT. Use the “Waiting List” registration type to let us know you have more Scouts that would like to attend.

The NYLT course simulates a month in the life of a troop in a six-day course. It reinforces and expands upon Be-Know-Do leadership. Scouts learn a number of leadership skills and concepts. The scouts learn about the stages of team development and how to match the most appropriate leadership style with the developmental stage of the individual or team. The course has many challenges for the scouts, including its culmination where they undergo a quest for the meaning of leadership!

The NYLT course has Eight Key Elements

- A month in the Life of a Troop
- Four stages of Team Development
- Leadership requires Vision, Goals, and Plans
- Toolbox of Leadership Skills
- Consistent Leadership Modeling
- Scout Oath and Law
- Fun!
