Sled Race Rules

- Minimum of 2 people with the sled.
- Scouts must stay with the sled, if someone falls, the sled must wait.
- Sled must remain on the ground.
- Sled must stay on the course. Short cuts will result in disqualification.
- Sled must have been checked in at registration and used in skills competition.
- No wheels on sled.

There will be 3 classes - Trophies will be presented to the winner of each class.

Please note that we are not being specific in terms of the skill being tested.

That is up to the person or group running the station and changes from year-to-year to be a challenge. However, they should be something that can be accomplished using skills in the Scout handbook.

Venue Rules (Subject to change depending on venue)

- There should be no vehicular traffic during competition hours, except for necessary staff.
 - Vehicles will need to be moved from camping areas into designated parking areas.
 - Once parked vehicles should stay parked.
 - When driving, please go slowly. A Scout's life is worth all your time!
- Camping will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Please *DO NOT* camp in an activities area or those marked as not available. Otherwise, you will be asked to move.
 - Please allow room to socially distance within your campsite and between campsites.
- Please follow the directions of the Parking and Event Staff.
- Map will be made available before event.
 - If necessary, we will deduct competition points for failure to comply.
- *No ground fires*, except where permanent fire rings exist.
 - In all other areas, they must be *contained and off the ground*.
- Scouts *must* stay away from water.
 - Anyone caught playing in the water will be asked to leave.
- In accordance with the Guide to Safe Scouting:
 - **alcoholic beverages and controlled substances** are *strictly forbidden*.
 - **smoking** during activities and in camping areas is *forbidden*; there will be a designated smoking area away from youth.
- There is no trash service. *Haul it in; haul it out.*
- Port-a-Johns will be distributed throughout the camping area, the competition area and near Registration.
- As good stewards of our environment and guests of the Parks Dept., we will be expected to leave the area as we found it – *or better*.

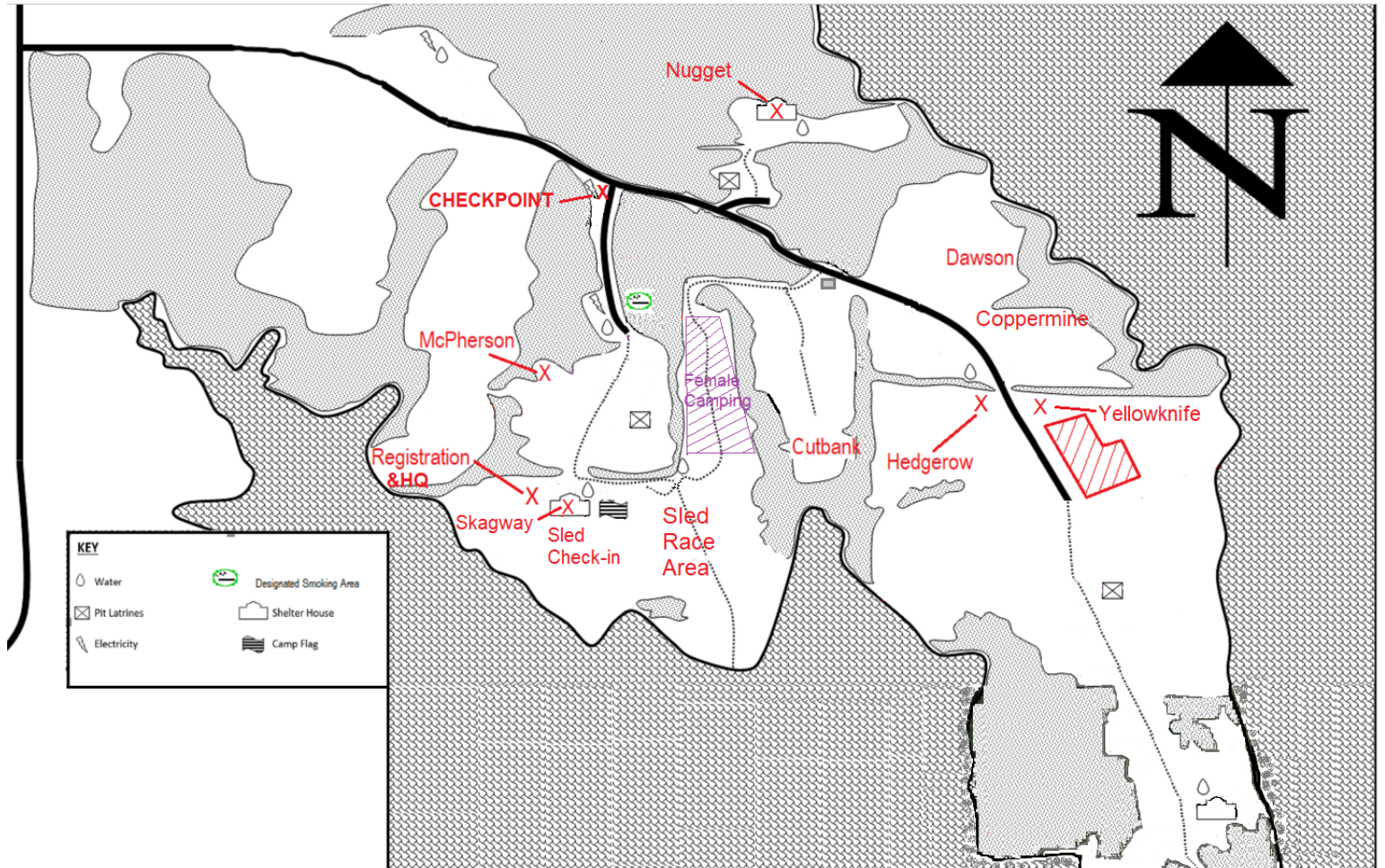

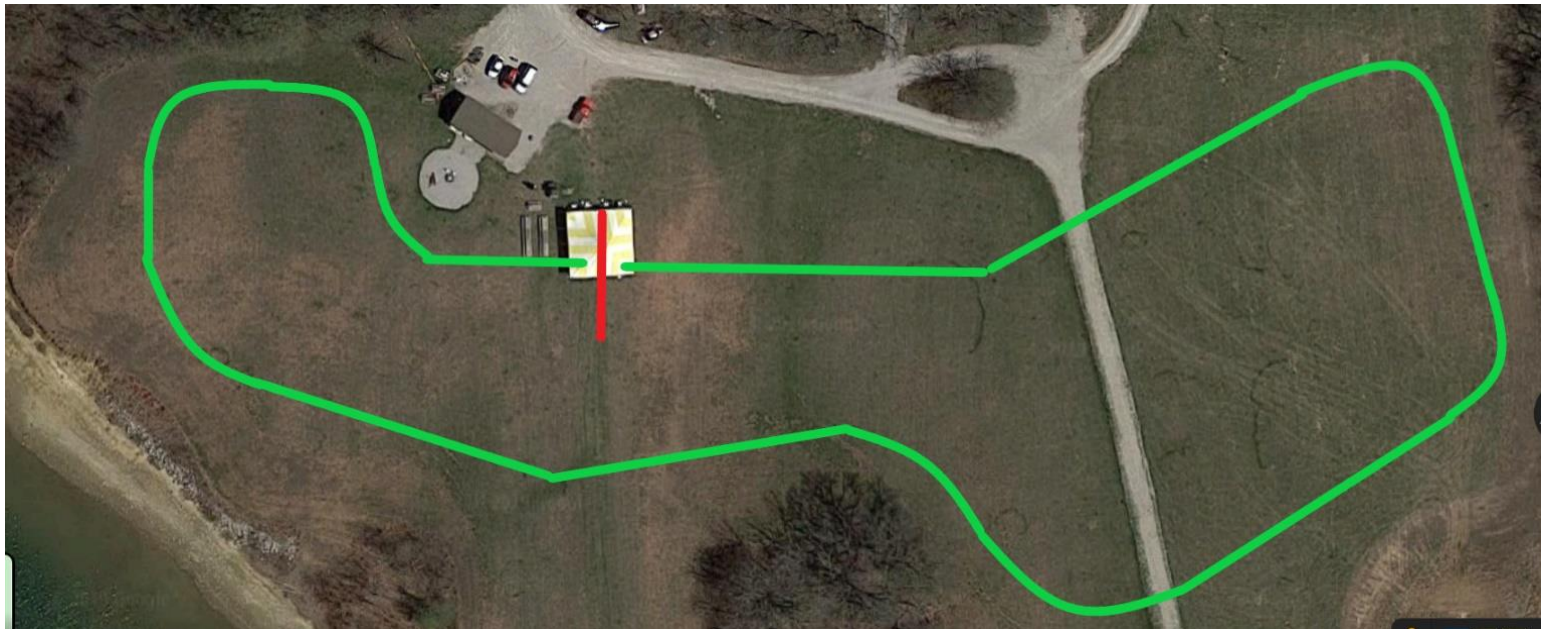

'Iditarod' (sled race) course

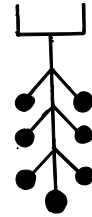
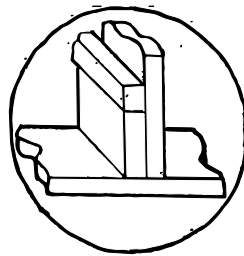
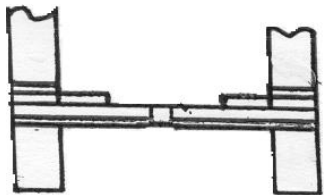
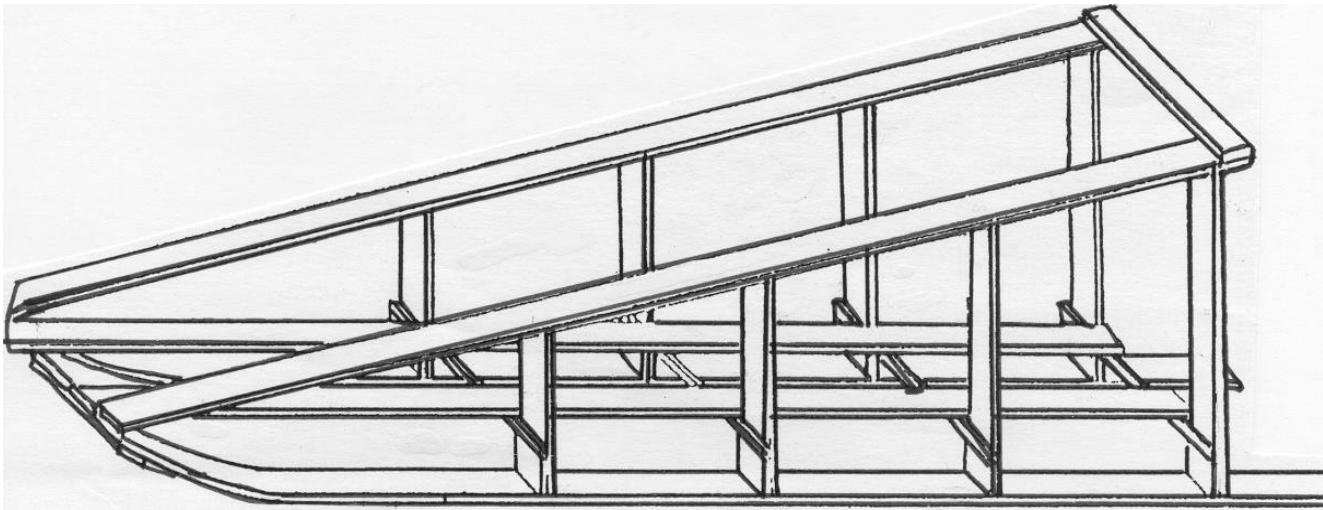

SLED REQUIREMENTS AND SUGGESTED PLAN

A diagram below is a suggested plan for your Klondike sled. You may wish to develop your own plans, decorations, and build your sled from native material. However, the following requirements are *mandatory*:

1. Sleds must be a minimum of 72 inches long.
2. Sleds must be a minimum of 24 inches wide.
3. A point will be deducted for each inch under the minimum length and/or width.



SUGGESTED MATERIALS

Two pieces 4"x1"x6'6" runners

Six pieces 1"x1"x24" Cross Supports

Four pieces 1"x4"x5' Floor Slats

Eight pieces 1"x2"x6" Upright Supports

Two pieces 1"x2"x40" Rear Uprights

Two pieces 1"x2"x12" Front Uprights

Two pieces 1"x2"x6'6" Hand Rails

One piece 1"x2"x24" Tow Bar

Plywood and metal can be substituted where desired.

Bolts, screws, nails as needed

Two pieces 1"x2"x33" Second Rear Uprights

Two pieces 1"x2"x26" Second Front Uprights

Please note that wheels will **NOT** be allowed on sleds. This will result in disqualification from the races and a loss of 20 points. The sled must be able to carry all items on the sled check-in list.
