### **Cub Scout Resident Camp (4 Day / 3 Night)**

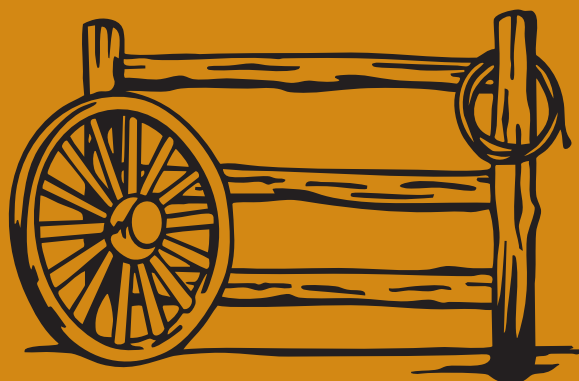
