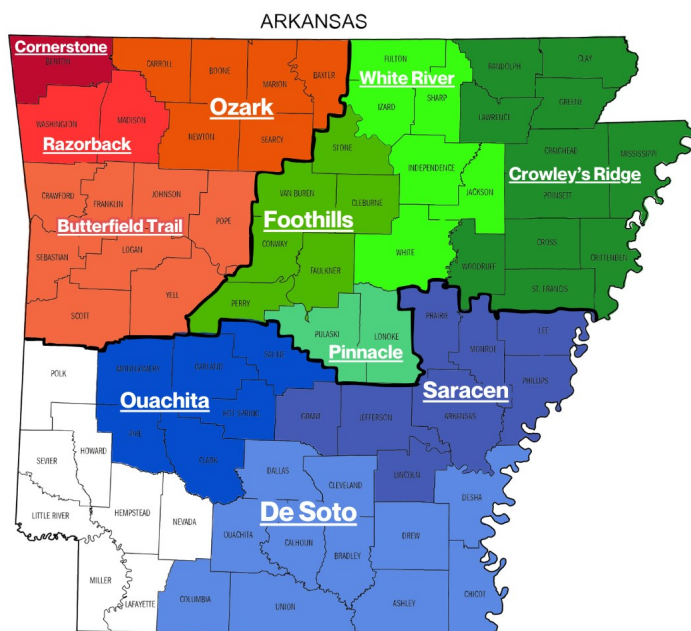

Family Scouting offering iconic Scouting America programs to boys and girls. Our Scouting America National Office made a historic decision to serve families by inviting girls into the Cub Scouts and delivering a program that will enable females to earn the rank of Eagle Scout.

Lions (Part of the Cub Scouts for Kindergartners) They've experienced the Scouting concepts of character development, leadership, citizenship, and personal fitness through engaging and exciting adventures!! A Lion learns by doing things themselves while having fun.

Cub Scouts (Boys and Girls in the 1st-5th grades) - Big Smiles Build Bigger Futures! It is a family centered program that develops self-esteem and encourages them to do their very best. The program offers fun and challenging activities that promote character development.

Scouts BSA (Boys and Girls in 6th-12th grades) - Turning Kids Into Tomorrow's Leaders! With more than 130 Merit Badges—from Archery and Art to Welding and Wilderness Survival—Scouting is the ultimate form of "learning by doing". Service, community engagement, and leadership development become increasingly important parts of the program as youth lead their own activities and work their way toward earning Scouting's highest rank, Eagle Scout.

Sea Scouts (Ships/Co-Ed ages 14-20). It is an educational, fun high adventure on sea and land.

Exploring (Posts/Co-Ed ages 14-20) is a worksite-based program for young men and women who are 14 through 20 years old. Has a focus on a single career field, such as: law enforcement, fire/rescue, health, law, aviation, engineering etc.

Venturing (Crews/Co-Ed ages 14-20) Helping Youth Discover Endless Opportunities! Venturing gives young men and women access to a range of programs, empowering them to create their own experiences. It brings Scouting values to life through both high adventure outdoor activities and challenging real-world projects.

School Impact Program (SIP) - Was designed specifically for at-risk youth with the concept of "bring the program to them". It's a community partnership where the educational, physical, psychological and social needs of families are the focus. SIP offers a comprehensive response to the needs of 21st century children and their families in hard-to-serve areas. In a traditional unit, the parents and guardians are leaders. In the SIP program, community leaders serve as role models and mentors.
