In consideration of being invited to participate in the CNCF End-User Supporter working group, you (“Company”) agree as follows:

1. Restrictions. Company understands that the End-User Supporter working group is restricted to companies who do not offer to sell, license or provide a service for cloud-native technologies to their customers. For avoidance of doubt, a Company offering a service that leverages cloud-native technologies but does not provide access to the cloud-native infrastructure services is the ideal End-User Approval by the CNCF Executive Director is required.
2. Participation. Company understands that End-User Supporters are expected to participate in monthly End-User Supporter working group conference calls with the CNCF. Company understands that End-User Supporters are expected to participate in at least one CloudNativeCon conference per year.
3. Removal. Missing four (4) consecutive meetings will trigger an evaluation for a Company’s removal from the End-User Supporter working group.
4. Termination. CNCF or company may terminate this Agreement, effective immediately, at any time, and with or without cause, by giving notice by email at the Primary contact email address then being used by the Company for End-User Supporter meetings.
5. Legal Effect. Company understands that this Agreement will represent a binding contract between CNCF and Company upon execution.
6. Non-Membership Participation. Company understands that the End-User Supporters are not considered a membership class under the CNCF, and as such, the benefits of membership do not apply.
7. Project Participation. Company acknowledges that any contributions or participation activities Company chooses to undertake within the CNCF are subject to adherence to the CNCF Charter available at: <https://www.cncf.io/about/charter>.
