DUE NOW:

1. **NYLT Course Information & Guidelines.** Please print a copy now so you and your parents can read and understand this booklet of information. It is very important that you thoroughly review these guidelines and attend one of the MANDATORY Parent & Scout Orientation meetings outlined in the booklet.
2. **NYLT Fire Starters.** Download and read this now so you have time to make your fire starters. You will need to bring 4 home-made fire starters to the course.

DUE PRIOR TO MANDATORY PARENT & SCOUT ORIENTATION MEETING:

3. **NYLT Annual Health and Medical Record Process.** This year, Samoset Council is using HealthForms.io to collect and manage medical records. Please follow the instructions closely to make sure you have your medical records uploaded to the site. Our medical staff will review the records prior to Course and discuss any questions with you and your parents during the check-in process.

DUE AT MANDATORY PARENT & SCOUT ORIENTATION MEETING:

4. **NYLT Code of Conduct.** Print, sign and bring with you a copy of this code of conduct. We have seen an increase in behavioral issues since Covid, so please make sure you read and fully understand what is expected of you during the course.
5. **Scout Medication & Treatment Form.** Print and complete this 2-sided form. This is used to record all dispensed medications & treatments during the course week, so must be completed by everyone. If you do not take medications, please indicate that by showing N/A on the first line. If medications change between the Orientation meeting and the Course, please bring an updated copy to Course. Medications must be in the original container.
6. **OTC Medication Approval Form.** Print and have your parents complete by crossing out any medication that you do NOT wish to receive.

Please wear your Scout uniform to the MANDATORY Parent & Scout Orientation meeting, as we will be taking participant pictures needed for the course.

We are sure you will find National Youth Leadership Training to be exciting, challenging, rewarding, memorable, and most of all FUN. As long as you come prepared to take an active part in the learning of leadership, you will have a great experience. We look forward to meeting you at the Orientation meeting in May, and then again at check-in on June 7th at Hanna Venture Base!
