National Youth Leadership Training is an exciting, action-packed program designed to provide youth members with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home troops, crews, ships, personal lives and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.

## What is NYLT?

NYLT is an advanced youth leadership training program. It is six days packed with fun and learning with the goal of building leadership skills that can be put to immediate use by our youth in their home units, schools and in their daily lives.

Based on a course outline supplied by the National Council of the Scouting America and delivered by an outstanding, youth-led staff, NYLT is designed to continue the leadership training started at the unit level. It is meant to support and enhance the guidance and mentoring of the Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor while pointing young men and women toward a higher level of achievement in Scouting and in life.

NYLT integrates the best of modern business leadership concepts with the traditional strengths of the Scouting experience. It centers on the concepts of what a leader must **BE**, what a leader must **KNOW**, and what a leader must **DO**.

## Who can attend NYLT?

In order to attend NYLT, a youth must have the following qualifications by the beginning of the course:

- Must be a registered member of a Scouting unit and have a recommendation from the unit leader.
- Must have a current BSA Health and Medical Record form parts A, B, & C.
- Scouts BSA (male and female) must be at least 13 and have earned the rank of First Class.

- Venturers and Sea Scouts (male and female) must be at least 14, or 13 and have completed eighth grade, and fall within the maximum age allowance for their program.
- They must have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills.
- It is recommended that they have had at least one year of camping experience. While NYLT is not an outdoor skills course, it is important that each participant have basic camping and outdoor cooking experience.

## Why should you attend?

- You will meet scouts from all across Theodore Roosevelt Council.
- You will push your personal limits and discover what kind of leader you can be.
- You will learn and develop new leadership skills.
- You will have committed to becoming the best leader you can be.
- The skills you will learn are used in school, in teams and throughout your lifetime.

## Why should Unit Leaders send Youth?

- We provide intensive leadership training based on the foundations of Scouting.
- Trained youth leaders make scouting fun for the rest of your troop/crew/ship members.
- You will take pride watching your Youth Leaders run the troop/crew/ship.

## Key Elements of the NYLT Course

NYLT is a course where content is delivered in person and in an outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun environment. Interconnecting concepts and work processes are introduced early, built upon, and aided by the use of mnemonics (memory aids), which allows participants to understand and more readily employ the leadership skills they have learned.
