



Boy Scouts...Feeling Adventurous?



Fill your winter with fun and fitness and earn the Snow Sports Merit Badge for either Downhill Skiing or Snowboarding at Thunder Ridge Ski Area, located nearby in Patterson, NY.

Scouts can spend time at Thunder Ridge and experience the thrills and chills of skiing or snowboarding.

The Ski and Snowboard Program is a **two-part** program.

First, on February 2nd, take a ski or snowboard lesson, learning the basics or improving your snow sports skills with our certified Ski and Snowboard instructors. During your downhill ski lesson, requirements 7d through 7i will be covered, for snowboarding requirements 7e and 7g through 7j.

Additional lessons may be required to achieve the level of proficiency in the standards set forth by the Boy Scouts of America.

Your on-snow day will include a 75-minute ski or snowboard lesson, rental equipment (if needed) and lift ticket for the day.

Then, on March 23rd, come back and speak with the great teams from the Ski Patrol & Rentals departments. They will go over all of the off-snow requirements including winter sports safety, how to get ready for the slopes, responsibility code, trail marking, lift safety, types of equipment, equipment and binding release & maintenance. (Requirements 1 through 7c & 7j for downhill option, 1 through 7d, 7f & 7k for snowboard option).

This day runs from 10am to about noon.

February 2nd & March 23rd, 2019 Merit Badge Days (must attend both)

Without rentals - \$85.00

With rentals - \$115.00

If you are in need of additional lessons between the February 2nd and March 23rd event days, a special Scout Rate is available.



For both days, you can bring a bag lunch or purchase your meal in the cafeteria.

Dress warmly & Bring your Scoutmaster signed blue cards!
Upon arrival, give your blue cards to the Council Representative waiting for you in the Ticket area.
