

Dear Leader / Parent:

Camping and other outdoor activities are an integral part of Scouting. It is impossible to enjoy the full benefits of the Scouting program without attending Cub Resident Camp, Webelos Resident Camp, Scout Resident Camp, or taking part in a High Adventure Trek. Scouting is about using your skills and enjoying the outdoors.

We feel so strongly about the outdoor program that we have made a commitment that no young person will be denied a camp experience due to financial constraints. To that end, the Westchester-Putnam Council has established a *Campership Assistance Fund* to assist Scouts and Families that need it.

The Campership Committee will consider camp scholarship applications for the Read Scout Reservation for Scout Camp, Cub and Webelos Resident Camp and Read High Adventure Treks. In keeping with the Scout philosophy, we ask that every effort be made by your Cub Scout, Scout or Venturer and their Unit to provide a portion of the camp fee. In the words of the Scout Law... "A Scout is thrifty... he works to pay his way and help others. He saves for the future. He carefully uses time and property."

While funds are limited, I would again stress that we are committed to providing scholarship assistance to ensure every youth member has the opportunity to attend camp. In order to fairly distribute the funds, our deadline for camperships requests is March 31. However, if a family situation changes or if a Scout decides to attend camp after this deadline, please be assured that we will consider a family's request. To be considered, the forms must contain all the requested information and be signed by the Cubmaster, Scoutmaster or Crew Leader prior to submission. Only fully completed forms will be reviewed. Incomplete forms will be returned and will not be accepted until all information is included. All requests for assistance will be treated in a confidential manner.
