# **RACE DAY SCHEDULE – April 5, 2025**

2:00pm to 2:45pm Check-In / Car Inspection (arrive in the beginning of the time slot to allow inspection;

racers who arrive in the last 15 minutes may not meet the cut-off time

2:45pm Cut Off Time: Cars must fully complete inspection by this time

~3:00pm to 4:15pm Opening Ceremony & Race

4:30pm Award Ceremony for Speed & Design

### **Online Registration is OPEN:**

- Deadline to Register: March 29, 2025
- Each Pack's Cubmaster or Committee Chair is required to register the winning racers from their Pack's Pinewood Derby. Parents do not register their scouts as individual racers.
- Fee is \$12 per scout (online payment).

# Online Registration Tips for Pack Leaders:

- Each Pack can register a maximum of one car per rank for a total of six racers. These should be each Pack's 1<sup>st</sup> Place Winners—one from each rank—Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelos and Arrow of Light scouts. If a Pack does not have a racer for all ranks, it may register fewer than six racers.
- If you are signing up less than six scouts, please email <a href="mailto:chughes108@gmail.com">chughes108@gmail.com</a> so we do not worry there is a mistake and think we are missing a scout/rank.
- If your 1<sup>st</sup> Place winner is not available, please invite the 2<sup>nd</sup> Place car as a substitute.

- **INCLUDE the scouts' name, rank and Pack during registration.** Name and rank are required for the racing software.
- If you forget to supply the names on the registration system, send an email to chughes 108@gmail.com with the name and rank of each racer.
- Pack leaders: Please FORWARD the event information to your racers so they have the Official Rules, racing schedule including cut-off time, and general event information
- Send your racers the Official Rules and let them know they must be PRESENT at check-in and wearing their CUB SCOUT UNIFORM (blue or tan uniform shirt and neckerchief/slide, or Lion t-shirt) to enter his/her own car into competition. Street clothes and Pack t-shirt are not suitable.

### **General Tips \*IMPORTANT HIGHLIGHTS\* for Your Racers**

The District's Official Pinewood Derby rules, regulations and specifications will be posted to the "Resources" tab at the event's online registration page. Be sure to review the Official Rules, regulations, and specifications in order to make sure that you and your scout have a fun time, with no surprises. Below are a FEW highlights to have a successful racing experience. This is not an exhaustive list. Please read the Official Rules for a complete information:

- Racers must be PRESENT at Check-in & Inspection and wearing their CUB SCOUT UNIFORM (blue or tan uniform shirt and neckerchief/slide or Lion t-shirt) to enter his/her own car into competition. Street clothes and Pack t-shirt are not suitable.
- Cut-off time for Check-in & Inspection is 2:45pm.
- All cars will be inspected and must meet the Algonquin District's Official Rules for construction including but not limited to:
  - · Maximum weight of 5.00 ounces without going over.
  - All four wheels must touch the track and roll. Must use the pre-cut slots for axles. Do NOT use axle guards; axles must be visible for inspection. No bent axles.
  - · Weights on the bottom of the car should ensure track clearance.
  - · No wet paint on cars. No loose parts.
  - Lubrication can be applied to cars before, but not after inspection/registration.
  - **Be Prepared for car inspection!** Racers are advised to bring a personal supply of weight and necessary tools to make adjustments during check-in/inspection.
