**Costs:**

- Includes lunch and patches for Cub Scouts

**Parking:**

- Available in the main parking lot (Paul Bunyan). You may also park to the right before the main gate/arch and along the driveway on the grass.

**Day Program:**

- Please check in at the registration table at Dingman cabin (right of Paul Bunyan).
- Program will be open style without a strict schedule to follow.
- Each family will be given a map and patches.
- Stations will be open between 9:00AM and 3:00PM.

**Lunch:**

- Lunch will be served in the dining hall. There is no additional cost for lunch.
