Septic Systems

The septic system is one of the most costly components of a home to replace and should be inspected once per year, including when the house has been listed on the market for sale or prior to purchasing. A septic system that has been adequately maintained can provide long-term, effective treatment of household waste. However, if it has been neglected it can fail at any time.
