WHAT'S INCLUDED

- 1 - Rack
- 3 - Lag screws
- 3 - Washers

WHAT YOU NEED

- Stud finder
- Drill with a 5/16" wood drill bit
- Socket or wrench
- Level

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Locate Studs.** Decide where to mount your Home Utility Ski & Snowboard Rack and locate the nearest studs. The rack's mounting holes are spaced at 16", which line up with the studs of most interior walls. Use a Stud Finder or Nail and Hammer to locate your wall studs. Do Not anchor through drywall only.
- 2. Mark Mounting Points.** The rack is secured to the wall with 3 lag screws that go through the rack's mounting holes and into the wall. Mark the locations of your 3 wall studs and confirm that the rack's mounting holes line up to your markings.
- 3. Pre-drill first hole.** Drill a hole into the wall at the center mounting point. The hole should go 2-3 inches deep and will be narrower than the lag screws; this allows the screw to grip.
- 4. Install first screw.** Place a washer on the first screw and push to the head of the screw. Next, push the screw through the center mounting hole on the rack and into the pre-drilled hole on the wall. Tighten to halfway point. The rack should now swivel around the screw.
- 5. Repeat for screws #2 and #3.** Pre-drill holes, then tighten screws with washers halfway into wall. If there are no spacing issues once all 3 screws are inserted, continue to tighten until all screws are fully into the wall.

USE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Weight Limit.** The weight limit of the rack is 100 pounds.
