

XML-RPC Ping List

Ping services allow your blog to automatically send out a signal (XML-RPC ping) to blog directories and search engines that your blog was just updated.

Warning: The default configuration of WordPress will notify your ping list every time you publish or save your pages or posts potentially causing you to spam the servers with requests.

To avoid this from happening, I do recommend you download the WordPress Smart Update Pinger plugin.
