Registration Information

- **Registration closes midnight, February 28, 2019** or once 90 registrations have been reached.
- Open to residents/fellows of Canadian universities.
- The Course is intended primarily for PGY 3-5 Neurology Residents
- Other individuals may also be interested and are welcome to register, including residents in related specialties, neurology fellows, and PGY 1-2 neurology residents.
- A limited number of spaces have been allocated for individuals who have completed their training and are practising in the community. These will be assigned on a first come, first service basis. - The registration fee is \$350 + HST.

Travel

- The Course will be held in Ottawa at the Delta Ottawa City Centre Hotel.
- Parking at venue and mileage reimbursement will be covered for registrants driving to the Course.
- Travel (by train or air) will be booked for registrants living outside Ottawa with the following conditions:
 - o A representative from the travel agency serving the Course will contact you shortly after registration to arrange travel bookings.
 - o To avoid unanticipated increases in fares, registrants will have 2 business days to respond to the travel agent with their flight selection. Registrants who do not respond within 2 business days will be responsible for paying any increase in fares that occurred since that communication.

- The fare covered will be the lowest available fare on a direct, non-overnight flight (or as direct as possible, if no direct flights are available). Fares will be Tango or equivalent. Depending on travel distance, arrival the day prior to the start of the Course (ie, April 4) may be required. Registrants who request an alternate flight will be responsible for paying the difference in fare.
- Registrants will be responsible for making any subsequent changes to their travel bookings and all costs associated with these changes.
- Ground transfers and travel costs other than those listed above will be the registrant's responsibility.

Accommodation

- Accommodation for registrants residing outside Ottawa will be provided at the venue, with the following conditions:
 - Accommodation will be provided only for the dates required to attend the Course (ie, April 5 and 6); accommodation will also be provided for April 4 for those travelling from a distance and must arrive on that date to attend the Course's start.
 - Registrants who choose to extend their stay before or after the Course will be personally responsible for the full cost of these additional nights.
 - Registrants will have the option to either share a room with another registrant of the same gender OR request a private room; those who request a private room will be personally responsible for paying 50% of the total room charge upon checkout.
- Registrants who require accommodation will be contacted by a representative from the Canadian Stroke Consortium the week of March 5 confirming the details of their accommodation booking.
- Accommodation will not be provided for registrants residing in Ottawa.

Meals

- Breakfasts and lunches will be provided for registrants. All other meals will be the responsibility of the registrant.
