I. Confusion about the Son of Man (18.31-34)
Note how many times Luke mentions what is written in Hebrew Scripture: Luke 4.17; 7.27; 10.26; 20.17; 21.22; 22.37; 24.44, 46; Acts 13.29; 24.14.

The Promise in our First Testament

2 Sam 7.12–16, the Promise to David of His descendent on the Throne, establishing the Kingdom! There is much here written of the Promised King!

Isa 7.14, [Matt 1.23]; the prophecy of a son born to a Virgin!

Isa 9.1f, [Matt 4.15f]; the prophecy and Promise of a child born to us whose name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace, with no end to His government, His Kingdom, His justice, His righteousness!

Isa 42.1, [Matt 12.18ff]; the prophecy and Promise of the Spirit filled, chosen Servant who brings forth justice on the earth, and more!

Isa 53.4ff, [Matt 8.17; Luke 22.37]; the prophecy and Promise filled in Jesus of the Suffering Servant who is pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our iniquities, chastened for our well-being — who bore “the iniquity of us all”!

Dan 7.13, [Matt 24.30; 26.64; Mark 13.26; 14.62; Luke 21.27;] the prophecy and Promise of “one like a Son of man” which is filled full in Jesus, the Messiah!

Mic 5.2, [Matt 2.6]; the prophecy and Promise of God’s eternal ruler born in the line of David, born in Bethlehem, filled fully in Jesus, the Messiah!

Zech 9.9, [Matt 21.5]; the prophecy and Promise of the humble king of salvation coming on “the foal of a donkey”! Filled fully in Jesus, the Messiah!
