#### Sin's Five Pointed Star

1) , *hata*, חָטָא, to "sin" is to "miss the mark."

2) , *avoun*, עָוֹן, "iniquity" is to bend and twist and pervert God's Word and God's Ways.

3) , *rasha*, רָשָׁע, "acted wickedly" is thoughts, words, deeds contrary to the Character of Adonai Elohim, that defames the Lord and often hurts those around us! At its core it is rebellion against the Lord's Word and Ways!

4) , *marad*, מָרַד, "rebelled" it to be "against," or "disloyal" to God's Covenant.

5) *sur*, סוּר, to "turn aside," often used to describe Israel's apostasy, Ex32.8; Dt9.12. To not "turn aside" is the mark of steadfastness.
