### Highway Markers for study of “The Revelation of Jesus Christ” —

- ⚠ The Purpose of Prophecy IS NOT to make us prophets!
- ⚠ The Purpose of Prophecy is its demonstration of the Accuracy of the Word of God which draws us to the Person of God!
- ⚠ The Purpose of Prophecy is to Reveal the Wisdom and Power of God!
- ⚠ The Purpose of Prophecy is to Reveal to us God's Design as Supreme!
- ⚠ The Purpose of Prophecy is to Protect Believers from Satan's Deception!
- ⚠ The Purpose of Prophecy is to Comfort God's People!
- ⚠ The Purpose of Prophecy is to Call us to Holiness!
- ⚠ The Purpose of “The Revelation of Jesus Christ” in particular is to set before us the 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming of Jesus!
- ⚠ There is the Danger of Sensationalism!
- ⚠ There is the Danger in Denial!
- ⚠ There is the Danger of being Puffed Up and Off Balance!
- ⚠ There is the Danger of reading all Scripture through the eyes of the church!
