

# Seeing the Church in the Minor Prophets-Part I

There are many in the religious world today who would consider seeing the church in the Old Testament impossible. Their conclusion would be based upon their belief in one of the most pervasive, yet perverted, teachings in denominationalism –the doctrine of premillennialism. It denies the possibility of seeing the church in any of the prophets.

The premillennial premise contends the church was never in the mind of God until after the Christ was rejected by the Jews and crucified. Before that time, according to this perverted teaching, Jesus came initially to establish an earthly kingdom. However, when the Jews refused to accept him as they awaited Messiah, this thwarted the Lord's plan. The Lord then established the church as a temporary institution, ushering in a parenthetical period, the church age. According to the theory, when the Lord comes again, He will succeed in establishing an earthly kingdom and reigning for a literal one thousand years in Jerusalem on the literal throne of David.

The theory purports to draw most, if not all, of its key points from one passage in the Revelation letter—Revelation 20:6. Yet, this text contains no hint of an earthly reign of Christ, a rapture, a tribulation of several years between a first and second resurrection, or any of the other major tenets of premillennialism. The thousand-year reign is, obviously, figurative; and there is not a trace of evidence to support the premillennial conclusions. In fact, their premise will crumble under the weight of prophecies in the Old Testament, which clearly predict the establishment of the church. If one definitive predictive statement about the church exists in any of the Old Testament books, the premillennial theory is nullified. In truth, not one, but many unmissable predictive statements among the prophetic books point clearly to the establishment of the church. The scope of this study will be confined to those pertinent prophecies in the Minor Prophets, particularly those among the last six books.

We will take a walk through this subject over the next few weeks to understand the truth of the Scriptures. Next week we will look at the kingdom and the church.
