



The church in the Minor Prophets, continued

Haggai, one of three post-exilic prophets (the period after the exile in Babylon), utters words in Chapter 2:6-9 that have their fulfillment in the kingdom which cannot be shaken, the church of Christ:

For thus says the Lord of hosts: "Once more (it is a little while) I will shake heaven and earth, the sea and dry land; and I will shake all nations, and they shall come to the Desire of All Nations, and I will fill this temple with glory," says the Lord of hosts. "The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine," says the Lord of host. "The glory of this latter temple shall be greater than the former," says the Lord of hosts. "And in this place I will give peace," says the Lord of hosts.

There can be no question as to the ultimate application of this prophecy to the church; the Hebrew writer removes all doubt in Hebrews 12:25-28:

See that you do not refuse Him who speaks. For if they did not escape who refused Him who spoke on earth, much more shall we not escape if we turn away from Him who speaks from heaven, whose voice then shook the earth; but now He has promised, saying, "Yet once more I shake not only the earth, but also heaven." Now this, "Yet once more," indicates the removal of those things that are being shaken, as of things that are made, that the things which cannot be shaken may remain. Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear.

When the Scripture provides its own interpretation on an Old Testament prophecy, can any honest student of the Word deny it? The Hebrews writer applies Haggai's prophecy to the dissolution of the Old Covenant and the initiation of the New, in which the kingdom, the church, is the undeniable and unending instruction in the writer's mind.

The words of Haggai 2:23 also find their ultimate fulfillment in the Christ, the chosen of the Lord, of whom Zerubbabel was merely a type: "In that day, says the Lord of hosts, I will take you, Zerubbabel My servant, the son of Shealtiel, says the Lord, and will make you like a signet ring; for I have chosen you, says the Lord of hosts." The phrase, "in that day," is a reference to the Christian age, that final dispensation, which began with the establishment of the church on Pentecost following the resurrection and ascension of Christ.

The church in the Minor Prophets, continued

It is indisputable that Zechariah is the most Messianic of all the Minor Prophets. As noted earlier, prophecy concerning the Christ, His crucifixion, and His coronation cannot exclude the church. The blood Christ shed in His death is the purchase price of the church, according to Paul's statement in Acts 20:28. Therefore, one cannot accept the cross without acknowledging the church. With this truth in mind, we examine two of Zechariah's prophecies concerning Christ and the church. The first reference is Zechariah 3:7-10.

Here Zechariah describes the "BRANCH," an undeniable reference to the Christ and the redemptive work He would accomplish though His sacrifice. The references to the removal of iniquity in one day in verse nine is reminiscent of Jeremiah's prophecy in Jeremiah 31:31-34. The Hebrew writer, in Hebrews 8:8-12 applies Jeremiah's prediction to the church. Zechariah's words must also apply to the kingdom now in existence, the church' of our Lord.

A familiar text regarding the church is in Zechariah chapter six. In this passage, as in the text in chapter three, verse eight, Zechariah identifies the BRANCH, the Messiah, as the one who would build the temple of the Lord (verse 12). In verse 13, the prophet repeats the prediction for emphasis and adds information that becomes the death blow to the premillennial premise that the kingdom and the church are not synonymous.

The prophet points out that the Messiah will rule in glory on His throne and that, during that same time period, He will be priest on His throne. Therefore, if one can find Scriptural proof that Jesus is priest now, then He must also be king now; otherwise, the prophecy of Zechariah is false. The Hebrew writer provides proof of the prophet's accuracy in Hebrews 4:14-5:6.

There is no doubt that, at the time Hebrews was written, Jesus had become high Priest in the heavens at the right hand of the Father. Therefore, Zechariah's prophecy in Chapter 6:12-13 had been fulfilled. This demands that Jesus is reigning over His kingdom now; He is both King and High Priest.
