

God's Promise About

Finding Wisdom

There are many promises of God that are so special depending on our needs at a particular time. Is there any promise more comforting than the one He made to us through His servant James? "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him" (Jas. 1:5). The omniscient God has promised to give us wisdom!



Look at the nature of this promise. First, it is universal to His children. This book is addressed to Christians wherever they may be found. That "the twelve tribes" (1:1) refers to spiritual Israel is confirmed when we note that the word brethren if found 15 times in this book. The promise is to any person who is His child.

Second, it is conditional. Wisdom will not be given until one asks—"Let him ask of God." Later in this same book James said, "Yet you do not have because you do not ask" (Jas. 4:2). How can anyone have any confidence that the decisions he is making are trustworthy, until he prays for wisdom? The next verse in chapter one adds another condition to receiving wisdom. When we ask, we must ask in faith. "But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind" (1:6). Prayer and faith go hand in hand.

Third, the nature of God is tied to the promise. He does not just give, He gives liberally and generously. Out infinite God never does things in small measures. When the text says He does this "without reproach," the emphasis is on the way He gives, contrasted with the way others give. They may give sparingly and give "lectures" along with gifts. This is not the nature of God.

Lastly, remember that the gift of wisdom is absolutely certain. It is not that God gives wisdom to all people some of the time. Nor does He give to some people all of the time. There is no partiality with God, for He gives wisdom to all of His faithful children, all of the time.
