



## The Problem of Evil-Part 2

What makes the existence of such phenomena a problem? Of course, there is always the practical problem of how to deal with or cope with pain and suffering. But the basic problem of evil is more theoretical than practical. That is, it is problematic to think that evil could exist alongside a particular view of God, specifically, the view found in traditional Christianity and presented in this book. It is the view that



God is all-wise, all-good, and all-powerful. The problem is this: how is the existence of such a God consistent with the existence of evil? It seems impossible that the following three assertions could all be true at the same time: "God is all-good." "God is omnipotent." "Evil exist." David Hume notes that Epicuru's old questions are still unanswered: "Is [God] willing to prevent evil, but not able? Then is he impotent. Is he able, but not willing? Then is he malevolent. Is he both able and willing? Whence the is evil?" (198). What kind of God really exists, then? How can we reconcile the existence of an all-good, omnipotent God with the existence of evil?

Many inadequate answers to this problem have been suggested. Some are unacceptable because they deny the biblical God. On the one hand, some have rejected an all-powerful God. He is good and does not want evil to exist, they say, but he is not able to prevent it or remove it. This approach to evil has considerable popular appeal, as illustrated by the fact that in the early 1980s one of the general best-selling books was Harold Kushner's When Bad Thins Happen to Good People. His basic thesis is that although God is good, he simply is not omnipotent. Thus, the world sometimes gets out of his control. Evil runs wild, and he cannot do anything about it.

The fact that this book was a bestseller shows that people are open to this explanation of the problem. However, in view of the Bible's teaching concerning the omnipotence of God and his sovereign control over all of nature and history, this is simply not an option open to the Bible believer. It is an inadequate solution.

A few others have dared to present the opposite option, that God is all-powerful but not all-good. Frederick Sontag, for example, says that is view of events such as the Jewish holocaust we must simply rethink our view of God. This means that "all easy and sweet views of God disappear," and "our notions of love must be rethought" (148-149). Such a view as this, of course, is completely ruled out by the Bible's teaching that God is good and all-loving.

We will continue our thoughts on the problem of evil next week.
