

It's Bigger Than You Think!

Have you heard about the most talked about subject in social media this week? A company CEO and his Chief People Officer were captured on a “KissCam” at a concert. Now, this may not seem like a big deal, but it was soon discovered that they were both married, but not to each other. In other words, their sin was brought to light. You may say “They deserved what they got.” Maybe they did. It seems like everyone has something to say about this incident, and comments about it are widely varied. Most likely none of us will remember these two or this incident for very long. But there are some who will remember for a very long time.

I would imagine their spouses will remember for a very long time. If their current marriages remain, it will only be with an extreme amount of work to re-establish the trust needed to remain married. I cannot believe that any children these two have will be able to forget this any time soon. Kids can often be cruel to one another about almost anything; I suspect they would be very inventive with the ways they come up with to tease and torment the children of this man and this woman.

Sin doesn't just affect the people committing the sin. Abraham's sin would affect his descendants for generations. Genesis 16:11-12. Theft affects the person who suffers the loss of whatever is stolen. It affects the police-man who is tasked to investigate, because he could have used the time spent for better purposes. Theft from a business affects us all, because prices go up to offset the cost of what's stolen, or products over a certain cost are locked up and we are forced to wait for the manager to come and unlock a cabinet or case so that we can purchase these items.

Sin often affects those around the sinner when he feels forced to lie to cover his sin, and friends or co-workers are involved whether they had anything to do with it or not. Sin is never a “private problem”. Sin always has a bigger effect than we think.

One drop of food coloring can have a big effect on a gallon of water. Two or three drops will change it's appearance completely. Use a second color and add a few drops and it will change again. As Paul said “a little leaven leavens the whole lump.”

Just as we can never be sure of how much good may come from simply sharing the gospel with someone, whether they respond immediately or not, we can never know beforehand what damage our sin may cause in the long run. Here is what we can be sure of; doing what is right in the sight of God is always good, and sin is always a bad thing. Let's concentrate on doing the right, and sin won't have nearly as much effect in our lives!

- † Roy’s Brother-in-law Mark Sawitsky has lung cancer and will have surgery in August to remove the right lobe and associated lymph nodes .

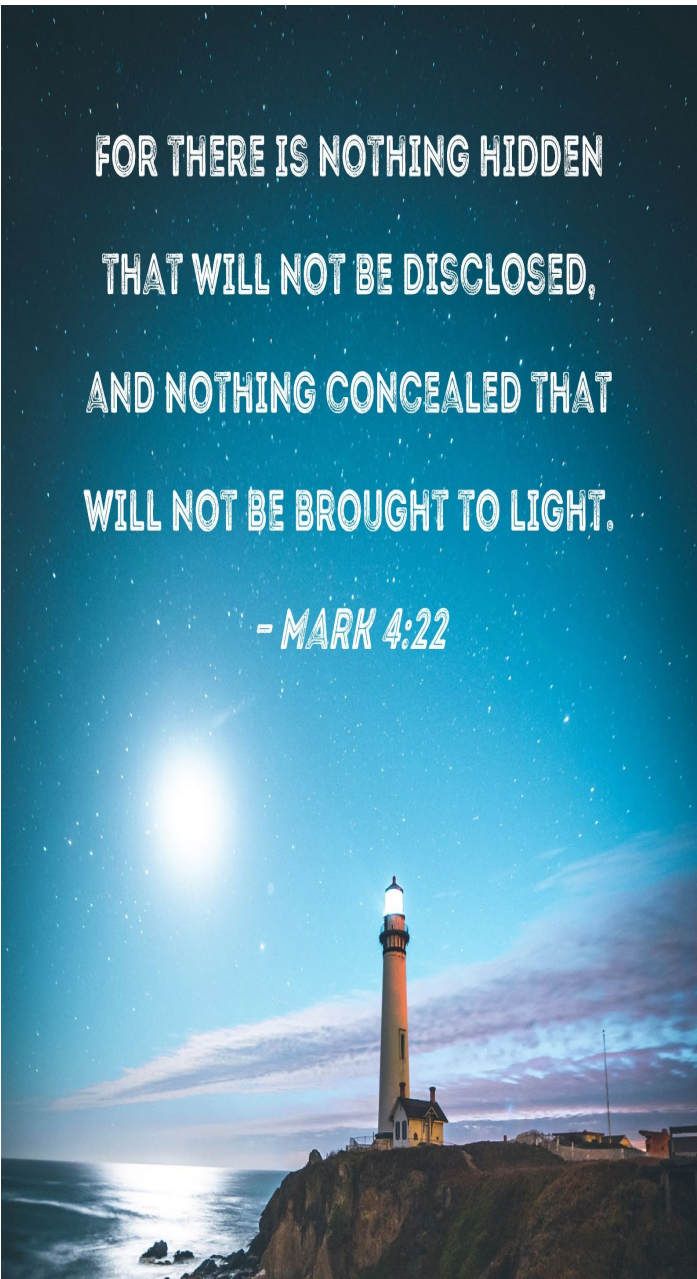
