



# Looking Ahead

I once heard about a driver who had no rearview mirror in the car. One day a passenger asked the driver why they weren't concerned about not having the mirror. The reply was simple "I'm not worried about what's behind me, I'm worried about what's ahead". This is good advice not only for driving, but also for life.

Paul could have easily let himself be reduced to sitting around, constantly worrying about his fate on judgement day after meeting Christ on the road to Damascus. After all, Paul had spent years doing everything in his power to destroy Christ's church and those who were following Him. If anyone had reason to be concerned about their salvation, it seems that Paul would be more nervous than most. Yet Paul didn't let what was behind him distract him from what he was pursuing. Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Philippians 3:13-14

We cannot always change what we've done in the past. Paul Couldn't change the fact that Stephen or any other Christians he had caused the death of was dead. He couldn't change that many Christians had lost their homes and possessions because of his actions. There was only one thing he could do anything about. While he had spent a lot of time and energy doing everything in his power to destroy the Lord's church, and oh, was Paul willing to do something about that. He worked tirelessly to spread the gospel in as many different areas as he could. He endured hardships that we can't imagine. He was beaten, shipwrecked, stoned, hungry, cold, and constantly in danger, whether in the cities or in the wilderness. Both his own people and the gentiles were a threat to him at different times. Paul stayed focused on what was ahead. The next opportunity to preach the gospel, the next time that he could encourage someone in service to Christ, and finally the judgement day when he would be rewarded for his labor.

We need to do the same. We may not be able to change what is past, but through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ, we can change where we're going. The Bible tells us "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" Romans 3:23, and the "wages of sin is death" Romans 6:23. However, Christ paid the debt for our sin and has given us the hope of eternal life, if we are willing to live for Him. We need to work for Christ and His church as we live here on earth. 
