

That’s Right, But That’s Not All!

I stopped at the gas station yesterday, and the person at the next pump went into the store and when he came out, he reached into his car, then stood up and walked around the pump and told me he wanted to give me something to read. What he gave me was a small tract that said “God’s Simple Plan of Salvation” on the front. I took the tract and put it in my truck. Later in the day, I took time to read it carefully.

It started by saying it would ask me the most important question in life; Are you saved? Well, I can’t disagree. That certainly is the most important question we can answer. It said I needed to realize that I am A sinner and referenced Romans 3:23. You can’t disagree with that. Then it told me the consequences of being a sinner and referenced Romans 6:23 and Hebrews 9:27. It went on to say that Jesus had died in my place, had become the sacrifice for my sin. Then it told me that God commands all men everywhere to repent, and referenced Acts 17:30. I really couldn’t argue with anything presented to this point. Then it referenced Acts 16:30-31 where the Philippian jailer asked Paul and Silas “sirs, what must I do to be saved?” and they said “Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved...” They conveniently left out verses 32-33 which clearly points out that they spoke the word of God to him and all his house and that they were all baptized that same night.

There was no mention of baptism anywhere in the tract. Although the scripture clearly demands it; Mark 16:16, Acts 2:38, Acts 8:36-37. Can you imagine what it would be like if your favorite navigation app just randomly left out a turn while it was directing you somewhere? It probably wouldn’t remain your favorite for long. Receiving only part of the directions for something is the same as receiving none at all, because in the end it leads to failure. None of us would settle for only part of the map to reach our vacation destination, nor would we use an app that we knew would only direct us halfway there. We certainly shouldn’t try to get to heaven with only part of God’s plan of salvation. Study God’s word to make sure you know the way!
