

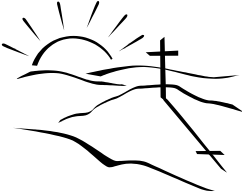

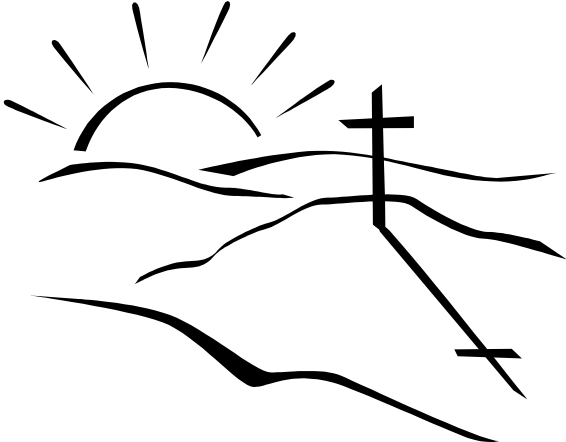

Sunday Morning Message: Foundations of Faith
Sunday Evening Message: Reflecting Jesus

The Foundations of Jesus Christ

Over the next few weeks, we will be looking at the Foundations of Jesus Christ in our Sunday Morning lessons. In Psalm 11, which serves as the basis for the study of “the foundations,” is applicable to David’s life as he faced his father-in-law, Saul, and his own son, Absalom, both of whom sought David’s demise as the consuming passion of their lives. Psalm 11 has been titled, “Faith, Not Flight,” and “A Song of Steadfastness.”

The term "chief cornerstone" originates from ancient building practices. The cornerstone was the first stone set in the construction of a foundation, determining the position of the entire structure. In the Bible, Jesus is repeatedly referred to as the cornerstone, emphasizing His unparalleled significance. Ephesians 2:19-22 states, "You are...built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone." Similarly, 1 Peter 2:6-7 and Psalm 118:22 reinforce this image, declaring that the stone rejected by builders has become the cornerstone.

This metaphor highlights several key truths. First, Jesus is the essential starting point for faith; without Him, the spiritual edifice cannot stand. Second, as the cornerstone, He aligns and supports all other aspects of Christian life—doctrine, community, and personal conduct. Finally, the rejection of Jesus by many underscores the radical nature of His mission and the necessity of accepting Him to experience true spiritual stability.

Alongside Jesus Christ, the Word of God—the Bible—serves as a foundational element for believers. Scripture is described as "living and active" (Hebrews 4:12) and as a lamp to guide one’s path (Psalm 119:105). The teachings, promises, and commandments contained within the Bible provide the blueprint for Christian living and spiritual growth.

The inseparable connection between Christ and the Word is evident in John 1:1, where Jesus is called the "Word" who was with God and was God. This identification means that to embrace the Word of God is to embrace Christ Himself. Scripture reveals God's character, His will for humanity, and the message of salvation through Jesus. It is both the record of God's redemptive acts and the ongoing guide for faith and practice.

For Christians, recognizing Jesus as the chief cornerstone and the Word of God as the foundation has profound implications. First, it calls for a personal relationship with Christ, built on faith, trust, and obedience. Second, it requires a commitment to studying and applying Scripture, allowing God's truth to shape every aspect of life.
