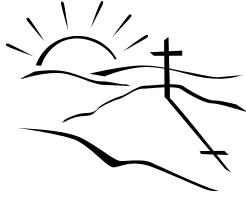

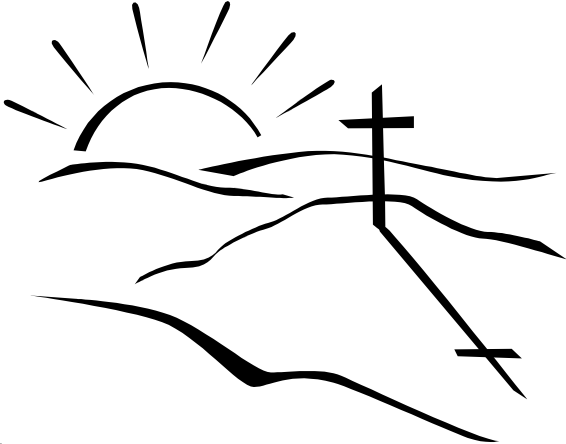

Sunday Evening Message: Pleasing the Lord

I am thankful for the church

We are deeply grateful for our church and its members. The church is more than just a building or an organization—it is a living body of believers who encourage, support, and uplift one another. The Greek word for church members is “*ekklesia*” which translates to “called-out ones” or “assembly.” It refers to a group of people called out from the world to form a congregation. Each person brings unique gifts, experiences, and perspectives, all contributing to a vibrant and loving community. Our shared faith unites us and helps us grow together in Christ.

As we look at a great passage, Ephesians 4:4-6 “There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.” This passage emphasizes that Christians are united in Christ by these shared beliefs and are called to live in unity with one another.

One body and one Spirit: All believers are part of a single spiritual body, guaranteed by the Holy Spirit. We are blessed to have one body, the church of Christ. If we had many bodies, then the world would be confused about a direction to follow.

One hope: Christians share a common hope for the future through their calling to Salvation. It is a blessing to have the hope of being part of a body that is going to heaven to be with Christ and God forever.

One Lord, One Faith, One Baptism: All believers share one Lord (Jesus Christ), one faith in Jesus (in Him), and one baptism for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; Acts 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21). The fact that there is one Lord is never a part of the discussion. One Faith and One Baptism should never be a part of the discussion, either. We are certainly blessed that if we read and study the scripture, it is very clear on these topics.

One God and Father: There is one supreme God who is above all things, works through all, and lives within all believers through the Holy Spirit. As a people and as a church, we are truly blessed by God.

This passage presents essential truths that form the basis for Christian unity. It speaks of the truth of the spiritual unity established by God. As Christians, we are all part of this one church, the body of Jesus Christ. We have the hope of spending eternity with Jesus in heaven. We are truly blessed people!
