



Sunday Evening Message: The Value of Jesus

Focus?

One night, walking down the street with nothing! I had no cell phone, no Facebook, no Television, no news in any way. I was alone with my dog and nature. I took a few moments to look around at the power of our God. Being disconnected, all my concerns go far, far, away. When you are in nature, it is the time to think about your focus on Jesus. We must understand that there is no equal to Jesus. There is nothing that is as important as Jesus. The one thing that we need the most in our lives is Jesus, our Savior.

Let us go to the book of Matthew as we see an interaction with Jesus and Peter. Jesus and the disciples had sent the crowds away. In the evening, Jesus went up into the mountain and by himself prayed to God. The disciples were in a boat which was a long way off into the sea with the waves battering against it. Matthew 14:25-29 (NASB) ²⁵ And in the fourth watch of the night He came to them, walking on the sea. ²⁶ When the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were terrified, and said, "It is a ghost!" And they cried out in fear. ²⁷ But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." ²⁸ Peter said to Him, "Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water." ²⁹ And He said, "Come!" And Peter got out of the boat, walked on the water, and came toward Jesus.

This is an amazing passage of scripture! How wonderful would it be to walk on the water toward Jesus. How wonderful it would have been just to see this amazing miracle happen. This is just a sample of the power of Jesus. We have an amazing Savior, our Lord, King, and Master Jesus Christ. If that had been the end of the story, it would have been wonderful. But as we know Peter lost focus. He began to let everything in this world that was happening take his focus away from Jesus.

Matthew 14:30-31 (NASB) ³⁰ But seeing the wind, he became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" ³¹ Immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and took hold of him, and *said to him, "You of little faith, why did you doubt?" Wow, this is what happens to us when we let the world take our focus off of our Lord Jesus Christ. Peter became frightened! This is something that happens to all of us. Let us do our best to keep our focus on Jesus. Please do not let this world rob you of your joy in Jesus Christ.
