Prayer is Powerful
Although my father left us for his heavenly reward in 1997, I can still hear his voice praying. I can see him down on one knee, as he always was in our home, praying to our God. He prayed for so many different things, for the church, for our family, for friends, for relatives, and for peace in this world. Many of my father's prayers were answered in a positive way. Some were answered in a negative way and some we had to wait for an answer. But God heard them all!
Prayer is powerful! I hope that you believe in prayer and its power. Prayer accesses the force that created the universe and lifted Jesus from the grave. When Elijah prayed, the heavens ceased to rain for three and a half years. When Hezekiah prayed, 185,000 Assyrian soldiers died. When the early church prayed, prison bars flung open, and disciples walked free.
The book of Luke is commonly referred to as the gospel of prayer. It says more about the prayer life of Jesus than any New Testament book, and it reveals how vital prayer was to the Savior's incarnation: "But Jesus Himself would often slip away to the wilderness and pray" (Luke 5:16). In the sequel to Luke, the book of Acts, we find that the followers of Jesus treasured prayer as well (cf. Acts 2:42; 6:4; 12:5, 12). Prayer is powerful, and Jesus and his disciples knew it!
We can have as much faith in the power of prayer as the prophets, apostles, and even Jesus had. We know that God hears the prayers. Proverbs 15:29 ²⁹ The LORD is far from the wicked, But He hears the prayer of the righteous. 2 Kings 20:5 ⁵ "Return and say to Hezekiah the leader of My people, "Thus says the LORD, the God of your father David, "I have heard your prayer, I have seen your tears; behold, I will heal you. On the third day you shall go up to the house of the LORD."
Lord help us to pray for your church here at Sunrise! Help us to grow in faith and knowledge and in numbers. Lord help us to do the things that we can do to help the church here. Lord, please help and bless us at Sunrise!
