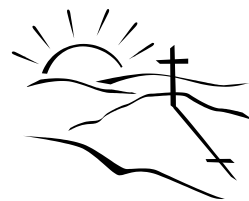

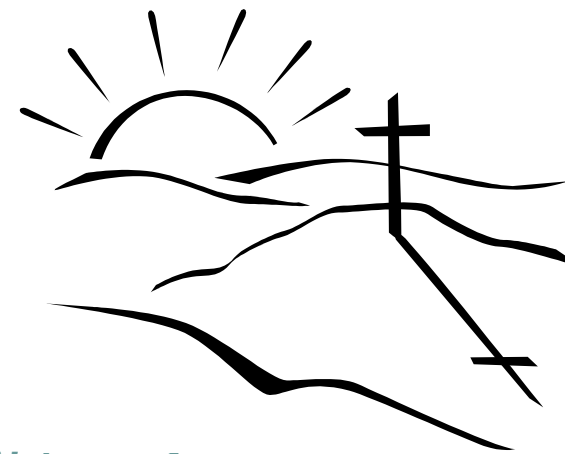

The Glory of the Heavenly Father God

The glory of the heavenly Father God is the radiant beauty of His holiness, power, and love. Scripture tells us, "The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork" (Psalm 19:1, ESV), reminding us that His greatness is seen in all creation. From the sunrise to the stars at night, every part of the world points to the majesty of the One who made it all. His glory is not only something we admire from a distance; it is the very presence of God that causes hearts to bow in worship and thanksgiving.

Throughout the Bible, God revealed His glory in unforgettable ways. Moses cried out, "Please show me your glory" (Exodus 33:18, ESV), and the Lord answered by passing by him in mercy and goodness. Later, when the tabernacle was finished, "the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle" (Exodus 40:34, ESV). These moments show that God's glory is not empty brightness, but the holy nearness of the Father, who desires to dwell among His people and lead them in truth.

The glory of the Father is also seen through His mighty works and through His Son. Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believed you would see the glory of God?" (John 11:40, ESV) before raising Lazarus from the dead. In that miracle, we see an example of the Father's glory bringing hope where there was grief and life where there was death. We also witness His glory when He answers prayer, changes a sinful heart, or gives peace in the middle of a storm. These daily mercies remind us that the heavenly Father is still working among His children.

As believers, we are called to live for His glory. The Bible says, "So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God" (1 Corinthians 10:31, ESV). When we walk in obedience, show kindness, forgive others, and praise Him in all circumstances, we reflect the greatness of our heavenly Father to the world around us. May our hearts join the words of Psalm 72:19: "Blessed be his glorious name forever; may the whole earth be filled with his glory! Amen and Amen!" (ESV).
