

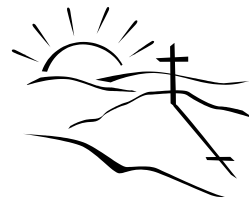

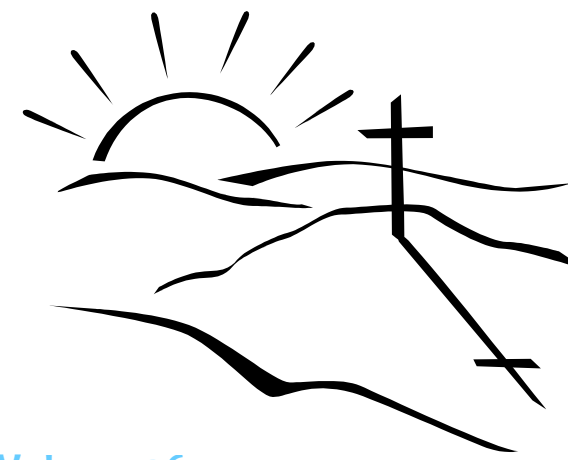

As the days grow warmer and the earth becomes full and green, we are reminded of the promise in Isaiah 43:19: "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it?"
