

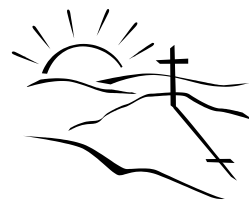

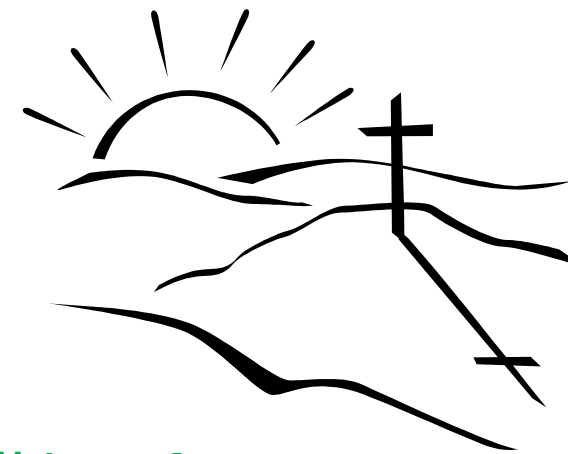

The Authority of God

God alone is the highest authority over heaven and earth. From the very beginning, Scripture declares His sovereign power: "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth" (Genesis 1:1). Because He is our Creator, He has the rightful authority to rule, guide, and sustain all things. His authority is not harsh or uncertain, but holy, wise, and perfect. When we come before Him in worship, we bow our hearts in reverence, acknowledging that He is Lord over our lives and worthy of all honor and praise.

The authority of God is clearly revealed through Jesus Christ. In Matthew 28:18, Jesus said, "All authority is given unto me in heaven and in earth." This reminds us that the God we worship is not distant, but actively reigning through His Son. True worship is more than singing words; it is surrendering ourselves in obedience to His will. May we honor Him not only with our words on Sunday, but also with faithful lives throughout the week, offering Him the worship, obedience, and glory that belong to His name alone.
