

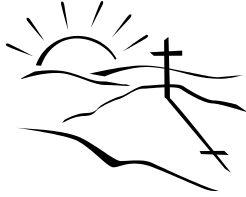

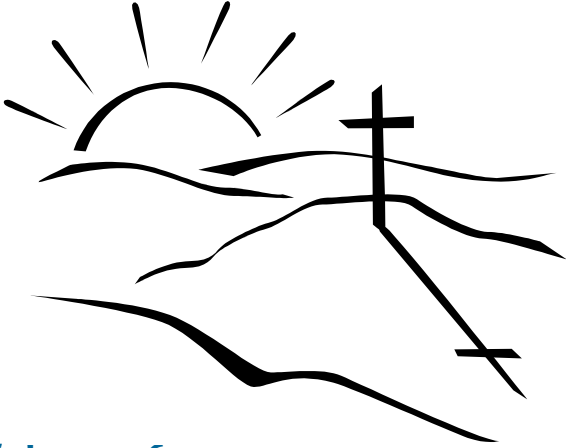

Taking the Lord's Supper

The Lord's Supper is one of the most meaningful acts of worship given to Christians. It turns our hearts back to the sacrifice of Jesus and reminds us that our hope rests in His body given and His blood shed for us. Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 11:23-24 (ESV), "the Lord Jesus on the night when he was be-
trayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.'" When we take the bread, we remember the body of Christ offered on the cross.

In the same passage, Paul also reminds us of the cup: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me" (1 Corinthians 11:25, ESV). The Lord's Supper is not an empty tradition, but a solemn and grateful remembrance. Each time we partake, we look back to Calvary, consider the cost of our salvation, and give thanks for the grace made possible through the blood of Christ.

The New Testament also shows the church gathering on the first day of the week to break bread. Acts 20:7 (ESV) says, "On the first day of the week, when we were gathered together to break bread, Paul talked with them." Following this apostolic example, we should take the Lord's Supper every first day of the week. Each Lord's Day gives us another opportunity to gather with the saints, examine ourselves, and remember what the Savior has done.

What an honor it is to be able to remember the Lord's death until He comes! Paul declares, "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes" (1 Corin-
thians 11:26, ESV). In this simple memorial, we proclaim a powerful message: Jesus died, Jesus lives, and Jesus is coming again. May we never take this privilege lightly, but approach the Lord's table with rever-
ence, gratitude, and hope.
