

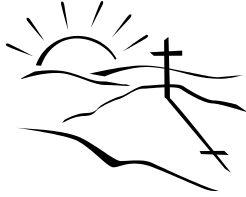

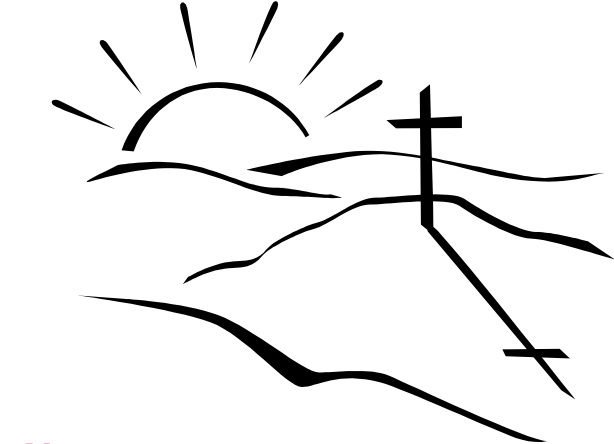

Growing Together Through Bible Study

Attending Bible Study is one of the blessed ways we grow together as Christians. God’s Word calls us to “grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ” (2 Peter 3:18, ESV). When we gather around Scripture, we are not simply gaining information; we are learning how to walk more faithfully with the Lord. Bible Study gives us a place to ask questions, receive encouragement, and allow the truth of God’s Word to shape our hearts, our choices, and our daily lives.

Bible Study strengthens the individual believer by helping us understand, trust, and apply the Scriptures. Second Timothy 3:16–17 reminds us that “all Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,” so that the servant of God may be equipped for every good work. As we study together, our faith becomes stronger, our prayers become deeper, and our spiritual lives become more grounded in the will of God.

Bible Study also blesses the congregation as a whole. Ephesians 4:15–16 teaches that, as we grow up into Christ, the whole body is joined together and “builds itself up in love.” When members study God’s Word together, we become more united in faith, more loving in fellowship, and better prepared to serve one another. A congregation that learns together is strengthened together, because each person brings encouragement, wisdom, and commitment to the work of the church.

As our knowledge of God’s Word increases, the church is helped to grow both spiritually and in number. Colossians 1:10 speaks of “bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God.” When we are rooted in Scripture, we are better equipped to share the gospel, welcome others, teach our families, and live as faithful witnesses in the community. Let us make Bible Study a priority, trusting that God will use His Word to strengthen our spiritual lives and build up His church for His glory.
