

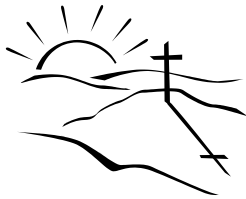

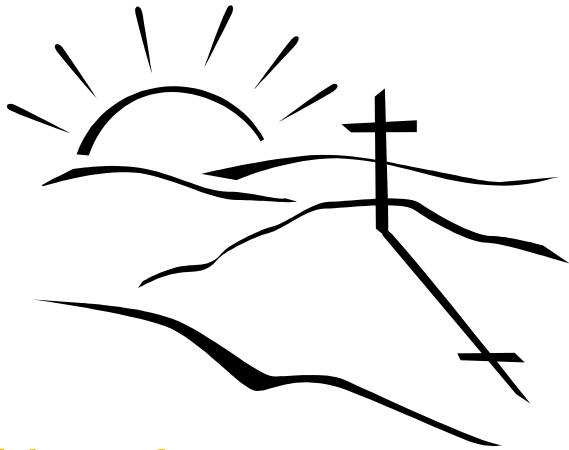

The Lord Hears When We Pray



Jesus is always ready to hear from us. We do not have to wait until our words are perfect or our hearts feel strong enough. He invites us to come to Him with our burdens, our questions, and our needs. In Matthew 11:28, Jesus says, "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest" (ESV). What a comfort to know that the Savior is not far away, but near to all who call upon Him.

When we pray, God hears us. Prayer is not simply speaking into the air; it is speaking to the living God who loves His
