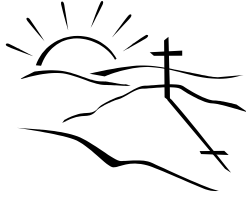

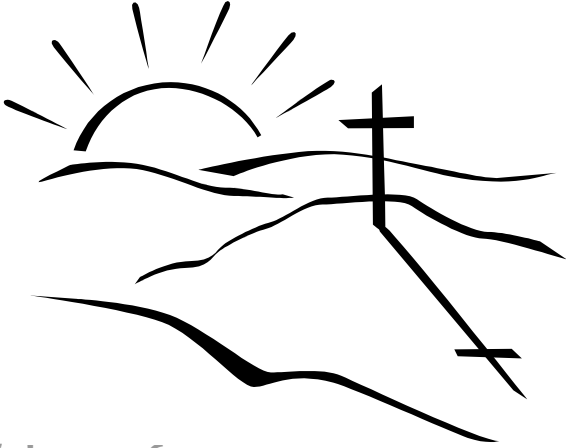

Showing Brotherly Kindness

Peter reminds us that spiritual growth is not meant to stop with faith alone: “For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue... and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love” (2 Peter 1:5–7, ESV). Brotherly kindness, or brotherly affection, is the sincere care believers show one another because we belong to the same Lord and the same family of God.

In a world where people are often hurried, divided, or discouraged, the church should be a place where kindness is plainly seen. Romans 12:10 says, “Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor” (ESV). This means we look for ways to encourage, listen, forgive, serve, and honor one another—not because it is always easy, but because Christ has first loved us.

Brotherly kindness grows through small, faithful acts. A word of encouragement, a phone call, a prayer, a meal, a visit, or a helping hand can remind someone that they are not walking alone. When we bear one another’s burdens, we reflect the heart of Jesus, who came not to be served but to serve.

This week, let us ask the Lord to make brotherly kindness visible in our congregation. May our words be gentle, our hearts be humble, and our actions be full of love. As we grow in brotherly affection, may others see Christ among us and be drawn to the Savior who teaches us to love one another.
