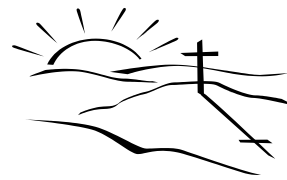

The Joy of Singing Praise

There is a special joy that fills the heart when God's people lift their voices together in praise. Singing is more than music; it is a thankful response to who the Lord is and what He has done.
