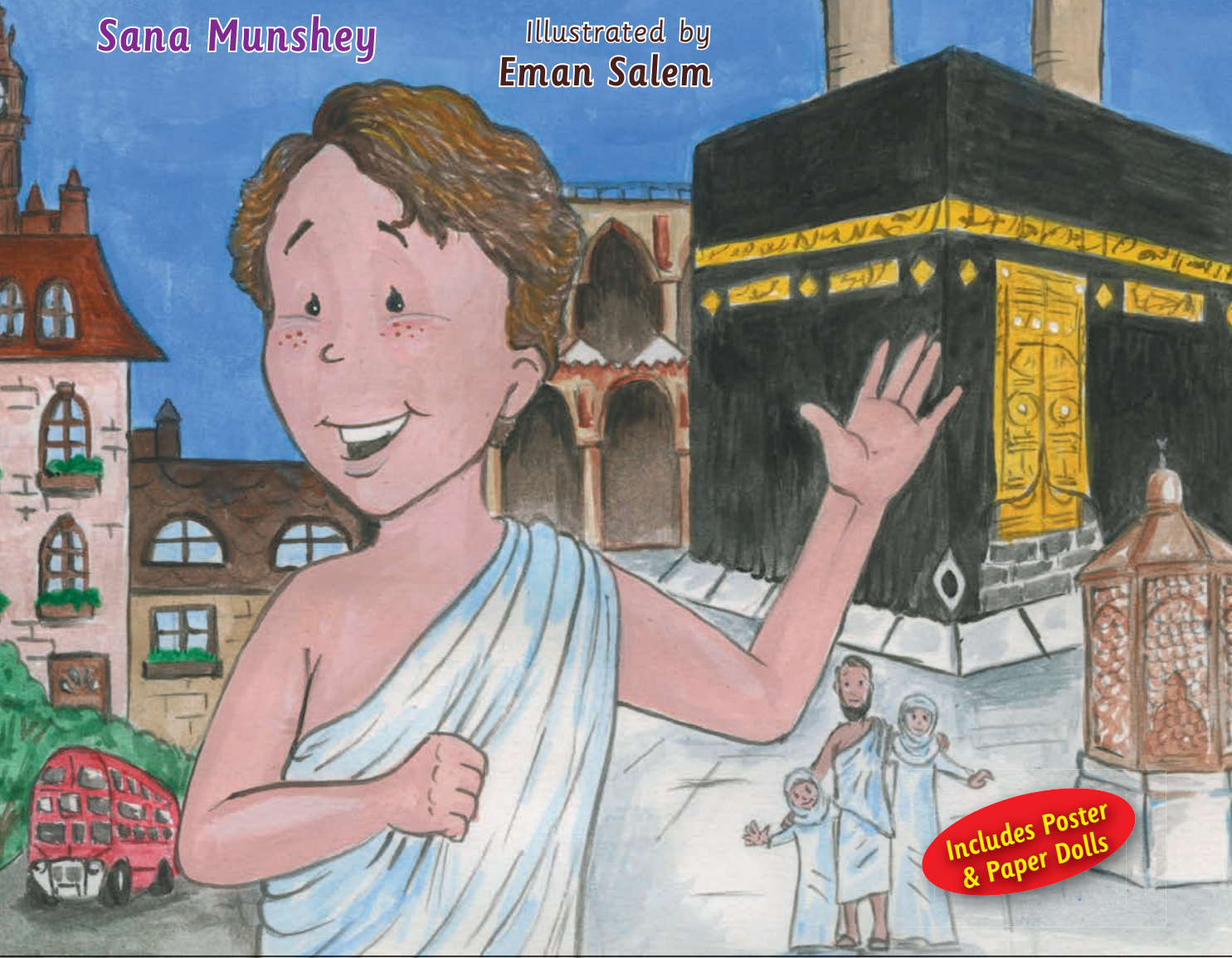



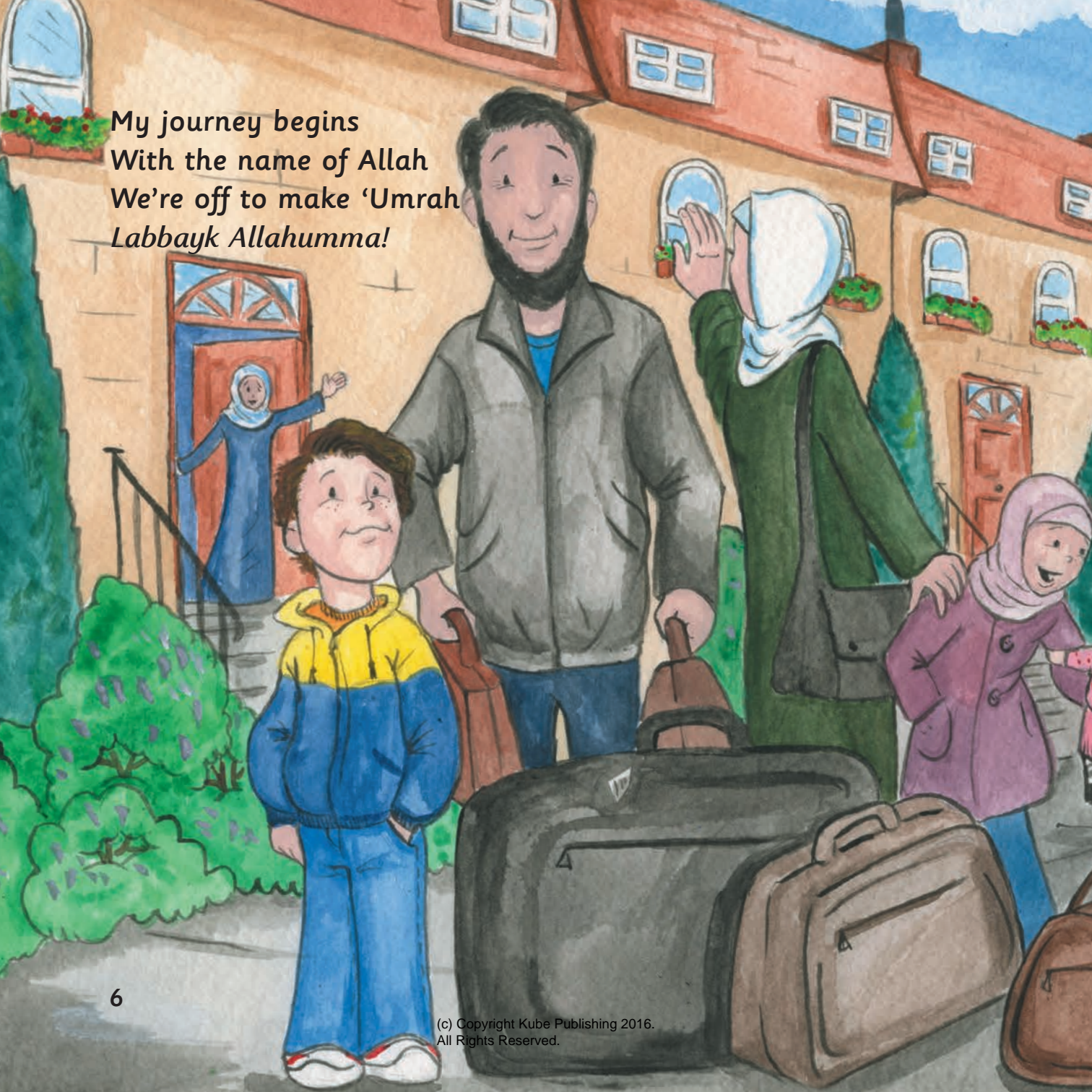
Salam, my dear friends,
