Restructuring and Creating New Memories, Memory Café Helps Couples:

Caregiving for those with dementia - an umbrella term for memory loss and other cognitive changes that can encompass more than a dozen diagnoses including Alzheimer's disease - can be stressful and lonely. Memory cafes exist to help shoulder a bit of the burden and provide community, activities and information for both the spouse (or caregiver) and the person with dementia. Memory Cafés have been happening in the Tampa Bay area for over a year with Dr. Cate McCarty, Dementia Coach, and her husband, Mike, who started experiencing early onset of dementia in 2016. These social gatherings are meant to stimulate memories, encourage discussion and offer supportive friendships.

Memory Cafés originated in Europe and have been rapidly spreading internationally. There are now 11 Memory Cafés in the Tampa Bay area with the newest one in Tarpon Springs thanks to local sponsors dedicated to dementia care support and awareness. This new Memory Café is held the 2nd Friday of every month from 11:00 am to 12:30 pm at Queen's Pizza & Restaurant, 40949 US Hwy 19 N, Tarpon Springs.

Trained in the best recreation and dementia strategies, Dr. Cate brings her own brand of engagement and humor to accompany the camaraderie and shared journey.
