TITLE: "GRACE, DON'T MISS IT"

TEXT: HEBREWS 12: 15 "See to it that no one fails to obtain the grace of God; that no "root of bitterness" springs up and causes trouble, and by it many become defiled;" What does this mean?

I. WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A COMMUNITY OF GRACE?"

TWO TRUTHS TO PONDER:

- 1. A COMMUNITY OF GRACE EXPERIENCES GOD'S GRACE, CELEBRATES THAT GRACE, AND EXTENDS GRACE TO EVERYONE, FRIEND OR STRANGER.**
- 2. A COMMUNITY IS COMPRISED OF INDIVIDUALS.**

II. AS A COMMUNITY OF GRACE, HOW ARE WE TO EXPRESS GRACE TO OTHERS?

1. Watch The Words We Use - "A gentle answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger."
-Proverbs 15:1

A. WHAT DID JESUS SAY ABOUT THE MANNER OF OUR SPEECH? Matthew 12:36 "I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak,"

B. WORDS MEAN THINGS

2. Let it Go-Respond to others with grace. "A fool shows his annoyance at once, but a prudent man overlooks an insult." -Proverbs 20:3

A. WHY ARE WE SO OFFENDED? Matt.13:57 "And they took offense at him. But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown and in his own household."

WE'RE OFFENDED BECAUSE:

1. A feeling of inferiority.
2. Rigid thinking.
3. Egocentrism

B. WHAT DID JESUS SAY ABOUT LETTING IT GO? Luke 17:1a "Then He said to the disciples, "It is impossible that no offenses should come," In v 3 he says," Take heed to yourselves. If your brother repents, forgive him."

3. Be A Blessing to Others- JESUS SAID IN Luke 6:31 "And as you wish that others would do to you do so to them."

So let's look at five ways to live by the Golden Rule...

1. Forgive as you wish to be forgiven
2. Help as you wish to be helped.
3. Encourage as you wish to be encouraged
4. Understand as you wish to be understood
5. Look for things to do to lift and bless those around you
