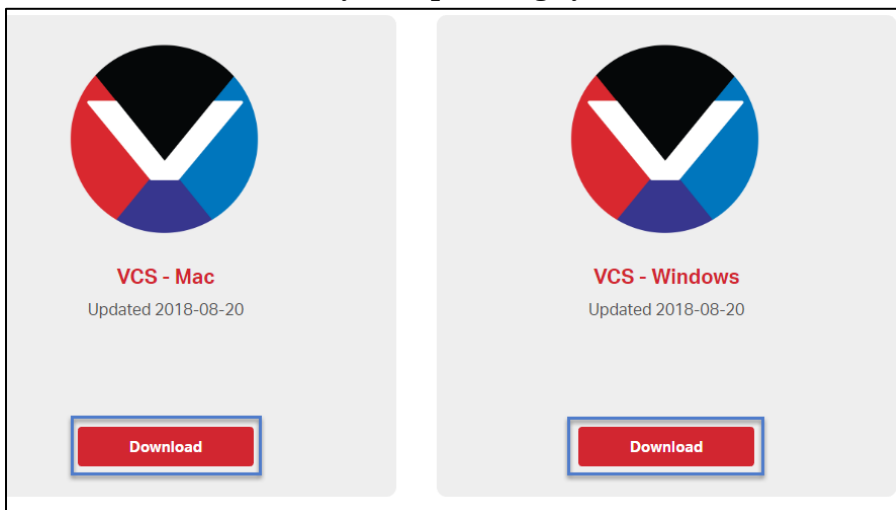
This is the Global Release version that VEX will be publishing on their website around the first week of September. When it is published on the VEX website, you will not need to update your version of VEX Coding Studio.

Before You Begin

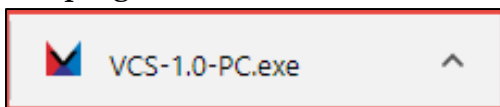
- Ensure that any other version of Vex Coding Studio PLTW or Beta version has been uninstalled from your machine for this release version to run properly.
- You have administrative rights to the machine that can install software and USB Drivers.
- It is also suggested that UACs are set to Never Notify, and anti-virus software is temporarily disabled.

Procedure

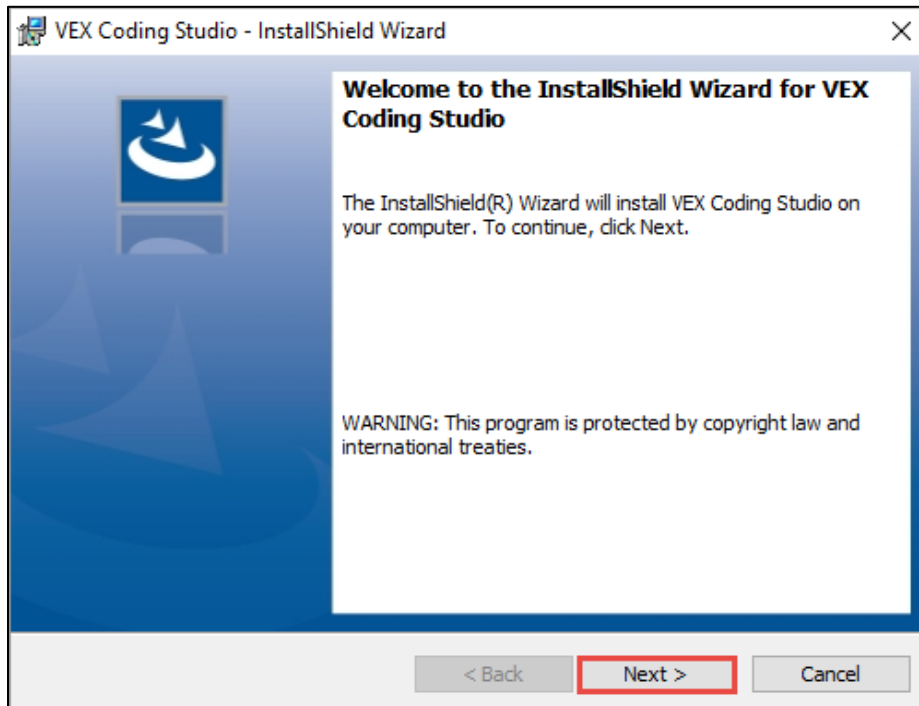
1. Select the link to <https://pltw.vex.com/pltw/download.php>
2. Select the download for your operating system.



3. The program will start to download. Select the download from where it is saved:



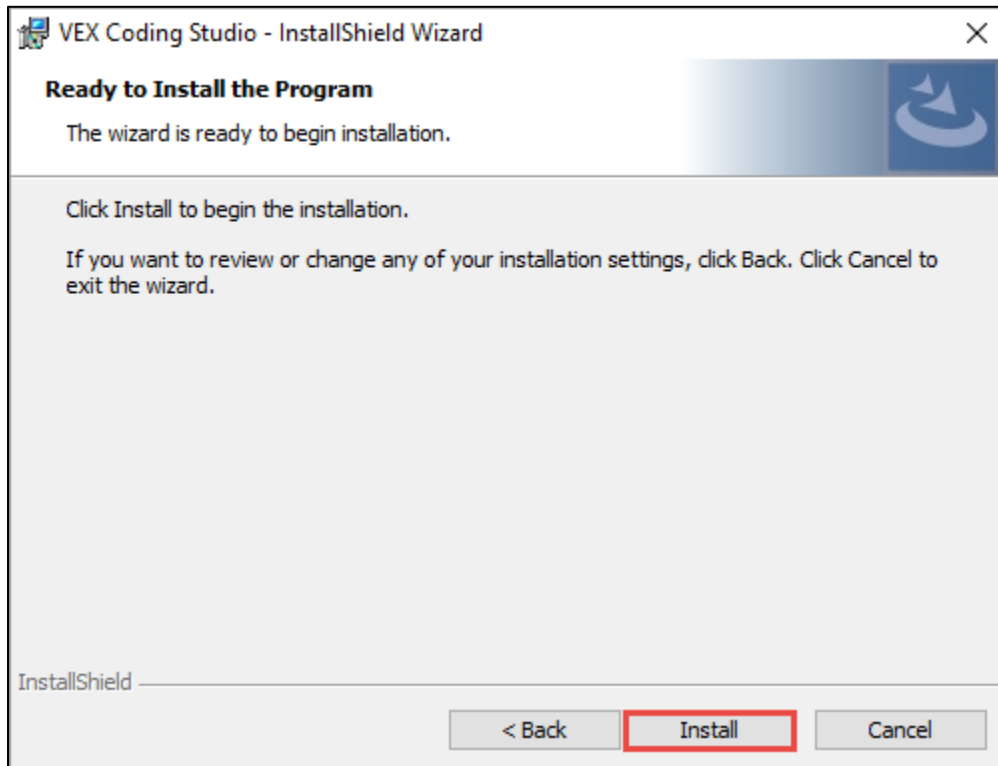
4. Select Next.



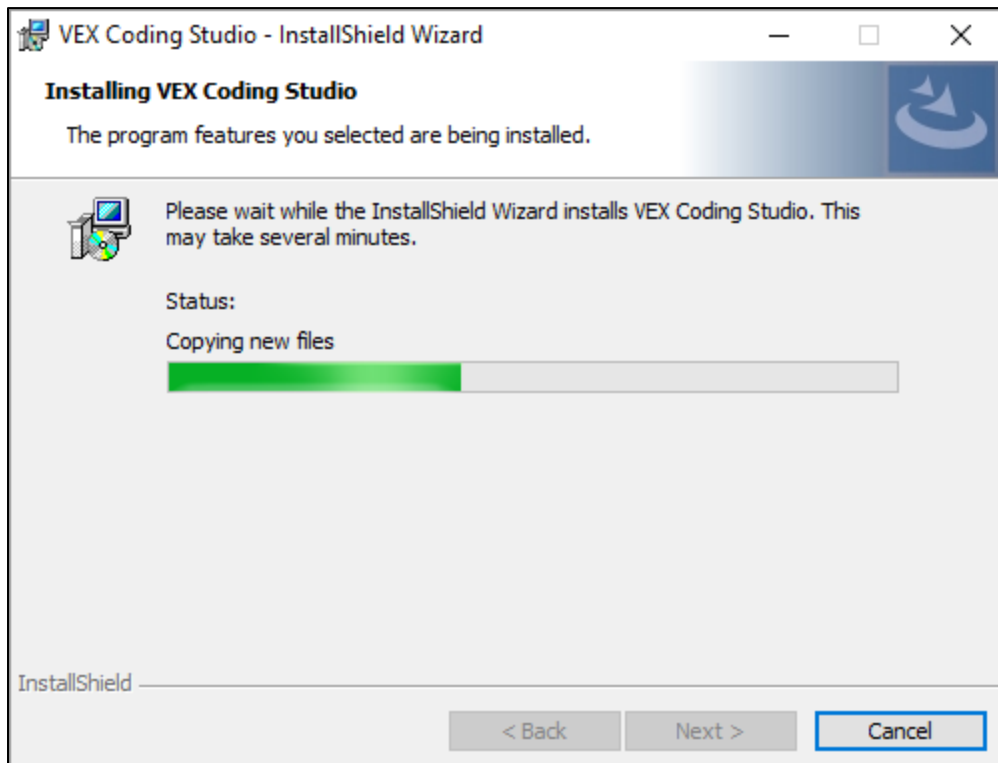
5. Select that you accept the license agreement, and select Next.



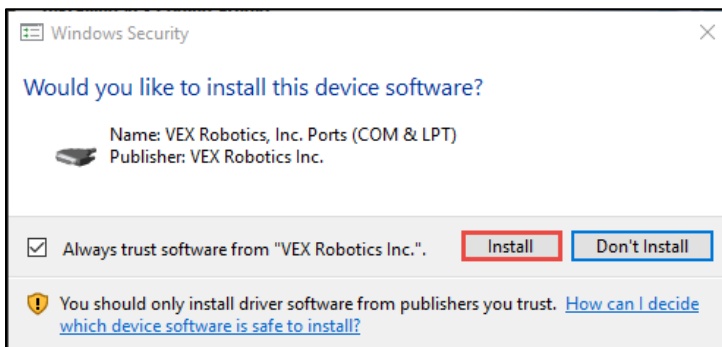
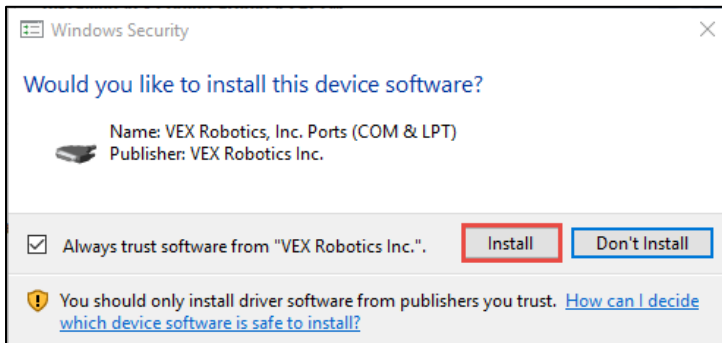
6. Select Install.



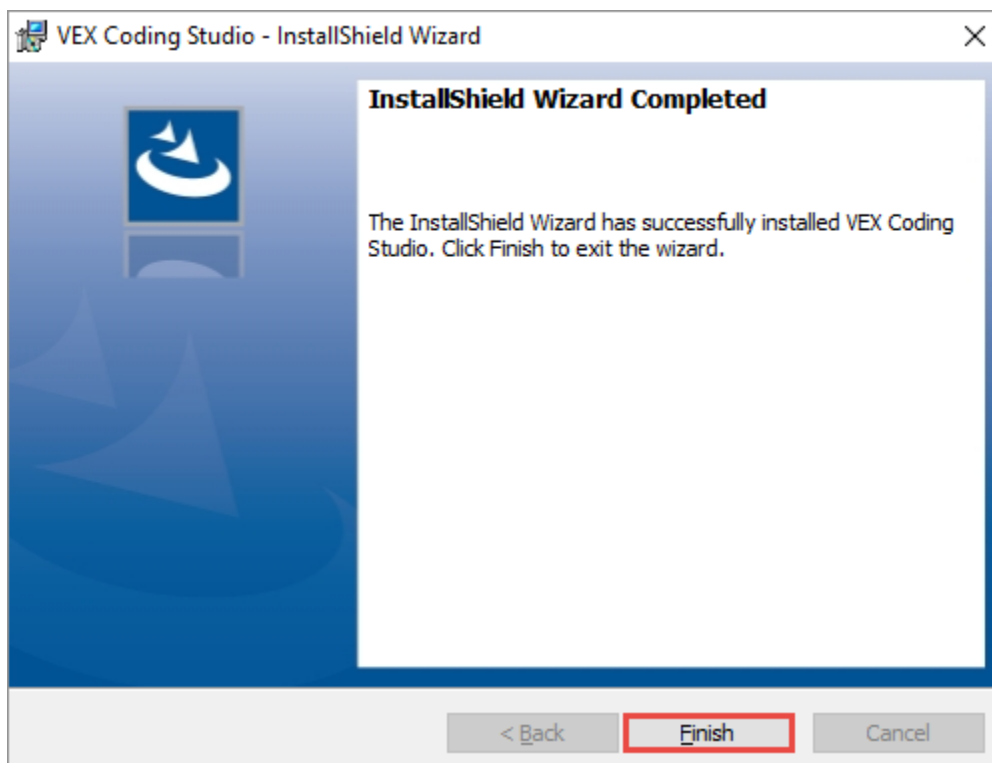
7. Vex Coding Studio will begin installing.



8. Two times you will be prompted to install drivers. Select Install for both of them.
