<p><i>I am assured all things work together for good.</i></p> <p>“We know that all things work together for the good of those who love God: those who are called according to His purpose.” – Romans 8:28</p>	<p><i>I am free from any condemning charges against me.</i></p> <p>“What then are we to say about these things? If God is for us, who is against us? He did not even spare His own Son but offered Him up for us all; how will He not also with Him grant us everything? Who can bring an accusation against God’s elect? God is the One who justifies. Who is the one who condemns? <p><i>I have not been given a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind.</i></p> <p>“For God has not given us a spirit of fearfulness, but one of power, love, and sound judgment.” – 2 Timothy 1:7</p>	<p><i>I can find grace and mercy to help in time of need.</i></p> <p>“Therefore let us approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us at the proper time.” – Hebrews 4:16</p>
<p><i>I am born of God and the evil one cannot touch me.</i></p> <p>“We know that everyone who has been born of God does not sin, but the One who is born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him.”</p> <p>– 1 John 5:18</p>	<p><i>I am the salt of the earth and the light of the world.</i></p> <p>“You are the salt of the earth. <p><i>I am a personal, Spirit-empowered witness of Christ's.</i></p> <p>“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” – Acts 1:8</p>	<p><i>I am a temple of God.</i></p> <p>“Don't you yourselves know that you are God's sanctuary and that the Spirit of God lives in you?” – 1 Corinthians 3:16</p>
<p><i>I am a minister of reconciliation for God.</i></p> <p>“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away, and look, new things have come. Everything is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: That is, in Christ, God was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed the message of reconciliation to us. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, certain that God is appealing through us. We plead on Christ's behalf, “Be reconciled to God.” He made the One who did not know sin to be sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.” – 2 Corinthians 5:17-21</p>	<p><i>I am seated with Christ in the heavenly realm.</i></p> <p>“Together with Christ Jesus He also raised us up and seated us in the heavens” – Ephesians 2:6</p>
