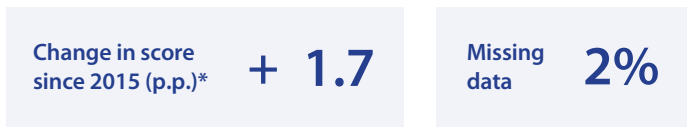
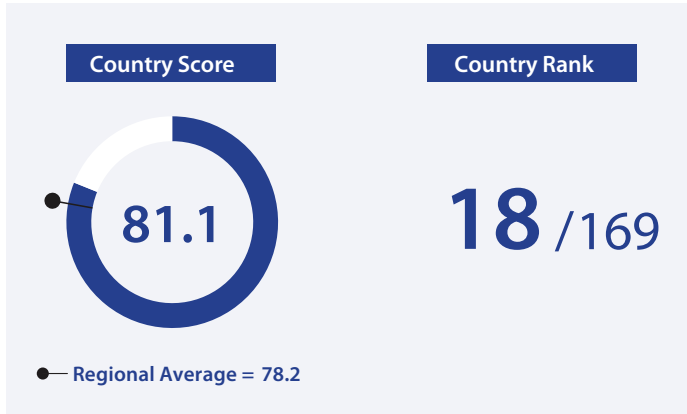
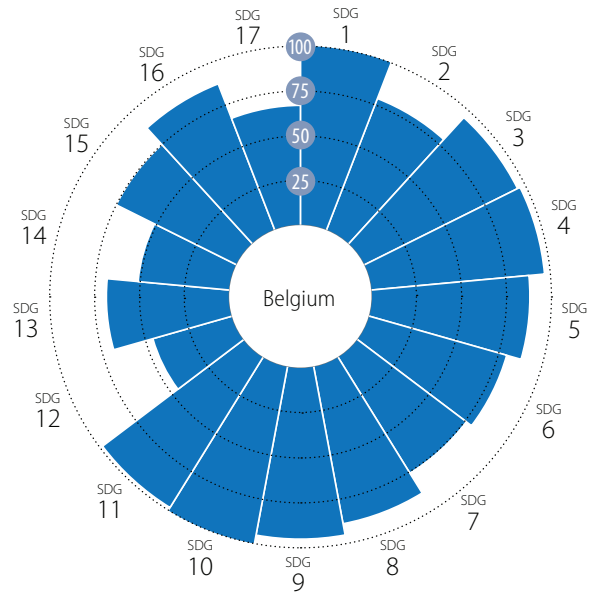

## Average Performance by SDG

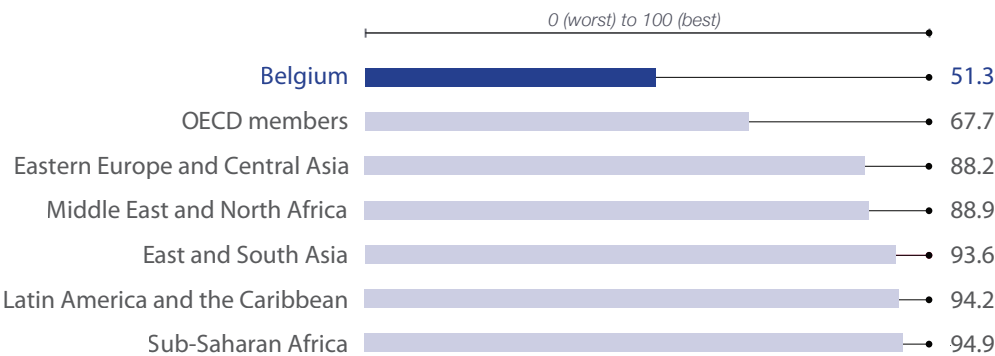
