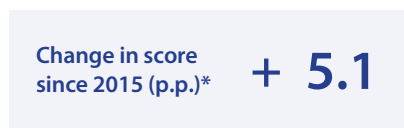
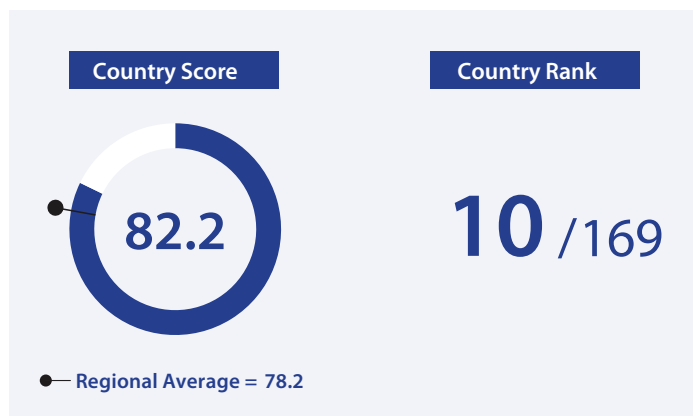
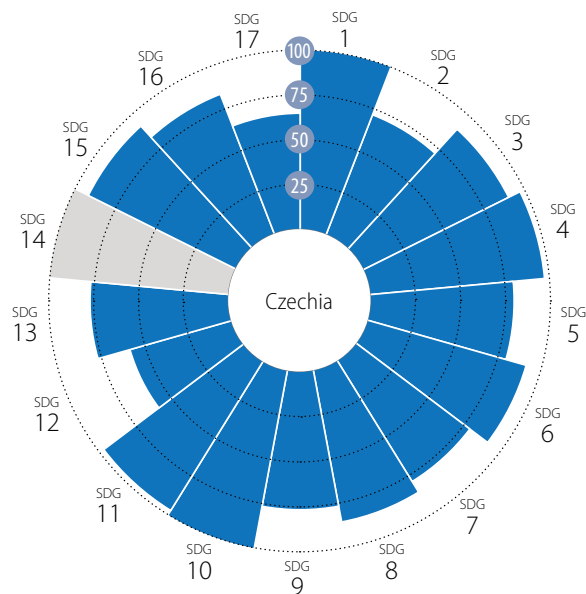

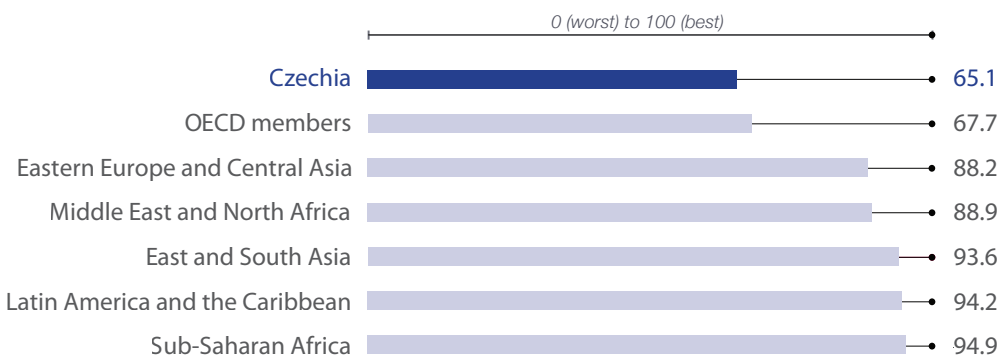
Average Performance by SDG
