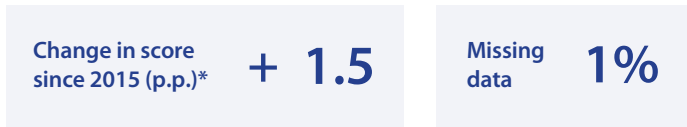
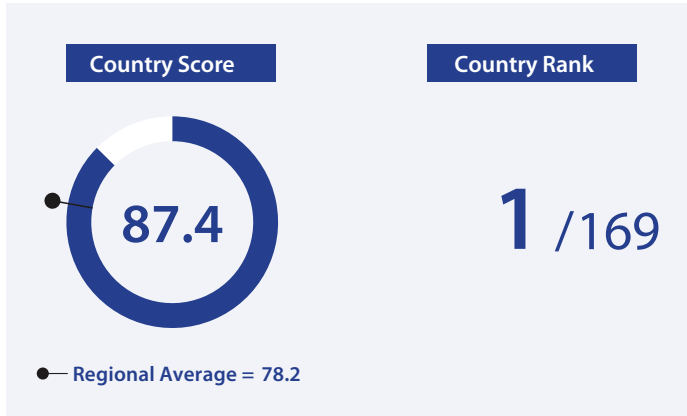
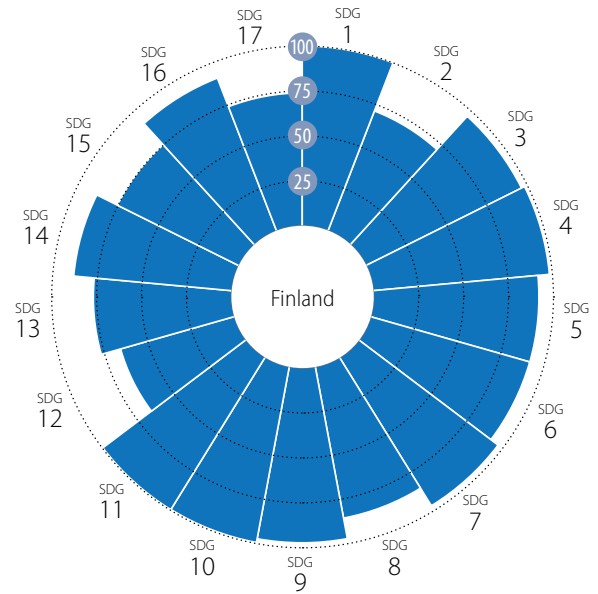

Average Performance by SDG

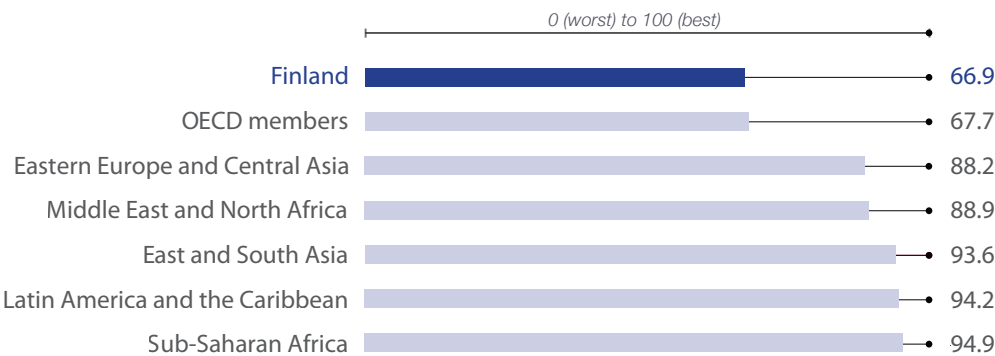
