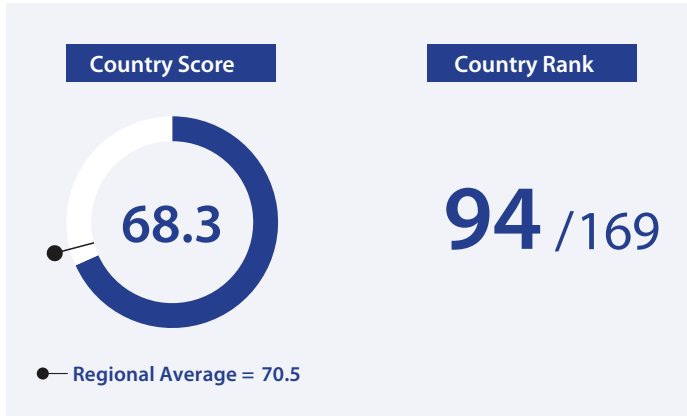
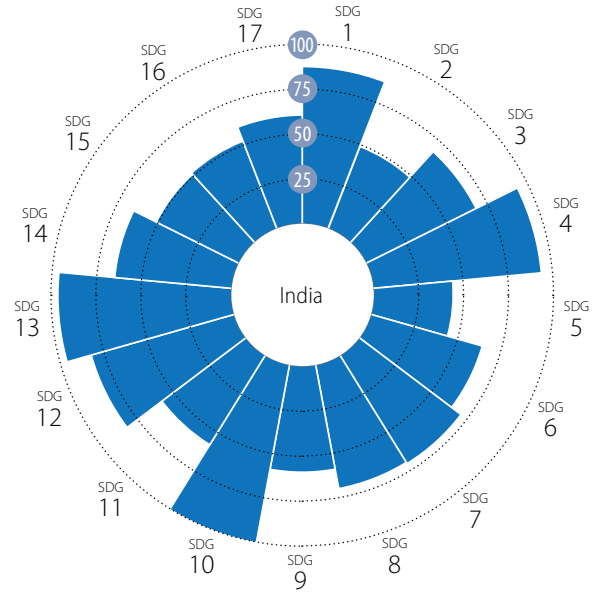

Average Performance by SDG

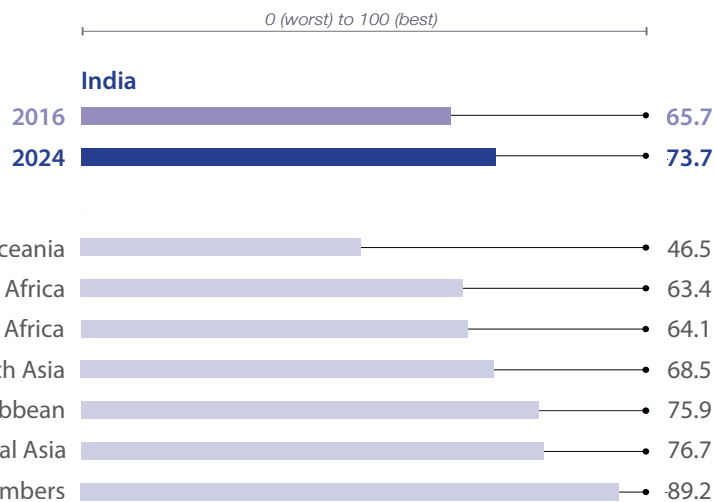
