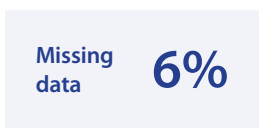
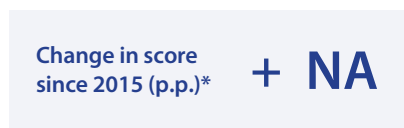
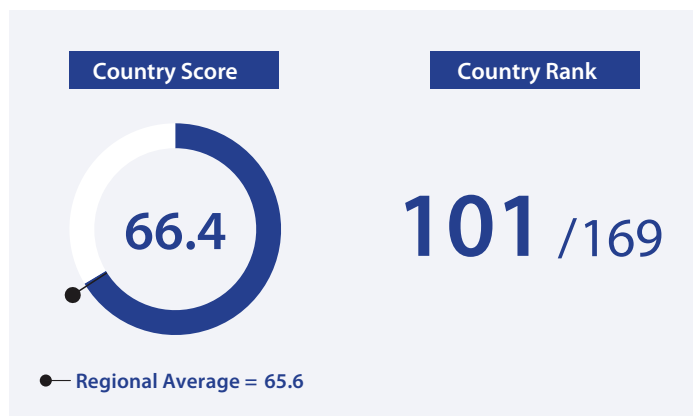
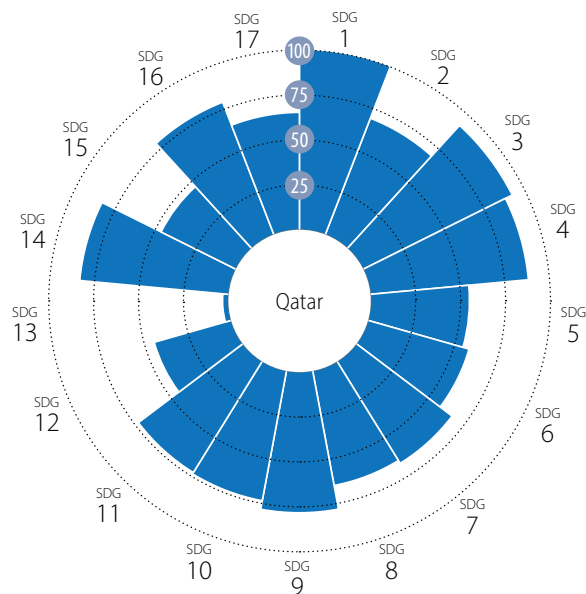


### Overall Performance



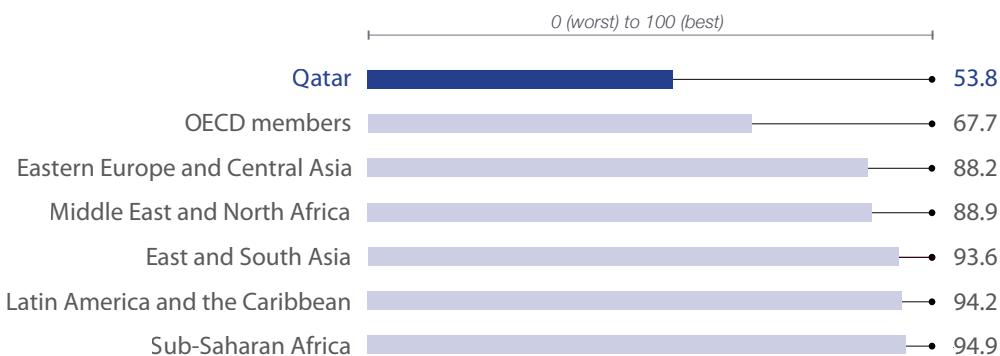
### Average Performance by SDG
