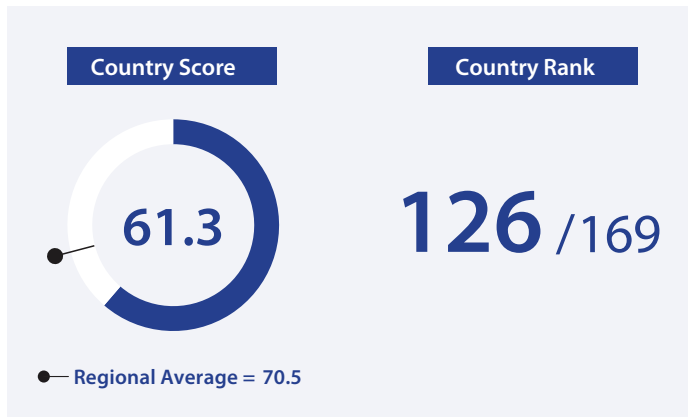
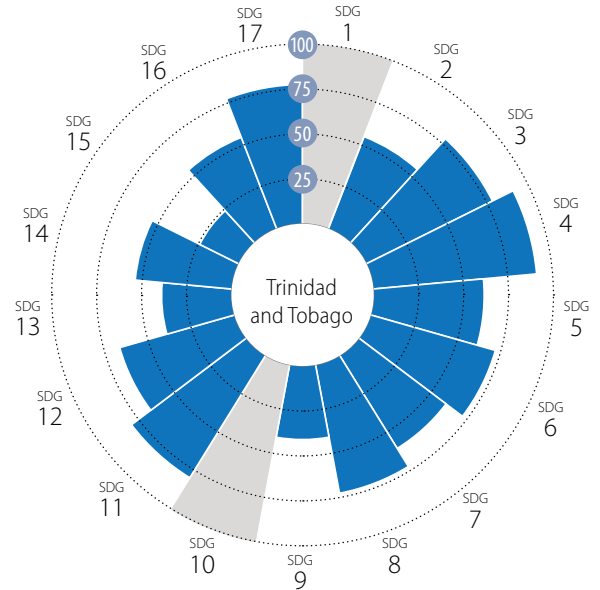

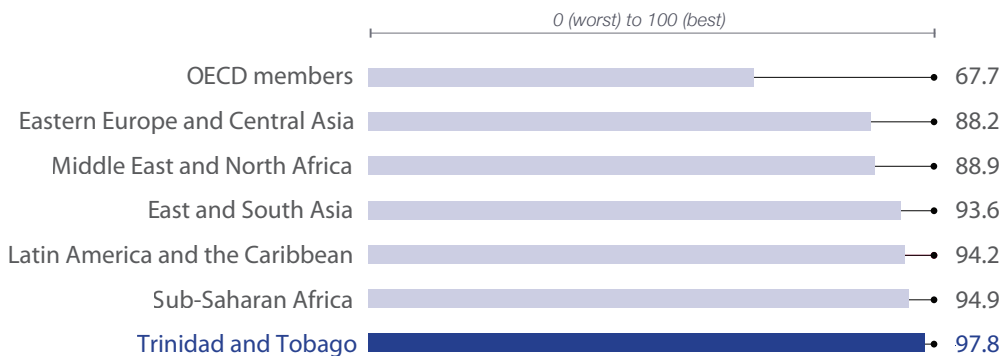
Average Performance by SDG
