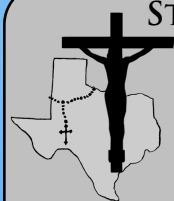


We implore St. Vincent Ferrer's patronage because he helped restore the Catholic Church during the 14th century when it was devastated by the Great Western Schism, rampant immorality among the clergy and lay faithful, and the encroachment of heretics, infidels and pagans. Already having lived a full life of service for the Church and of great sanctity, St. Vincent was forty years old and on death's bed when Our Lord, St. Dominic, and St. Francis appeared to him in a private revelation. They entrusted this Valencia-born Spaniard with a unique divine mission, which he faithful and tirelessly carried out as an itinerant missionary preacher. With the full authority and power of a papal legate, he unceasingly traversed the European continent for twenty more years until God called him to his eternal rest. God used St. Vincent as His instrument to call a decadent Christendom to repent and do penance in order to be saved from cataclysmic end time disasters - he was the *Angel of the Apocalypse*. Through St. Vincent, God brought about tens of thousands of conversions, among both believers and unbelievers. As a Dominican, he had a fervent devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and her most holy rosary. Moreover, his preaching is unsurpassed and his countless miracles (begun while he was yet in the womb) are unparalleled in the history of Christianity.

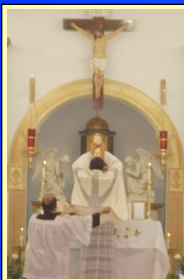

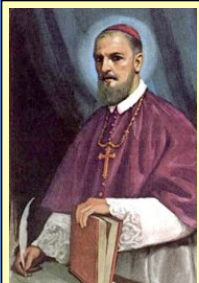


The Enemies of our Soul's Salvation

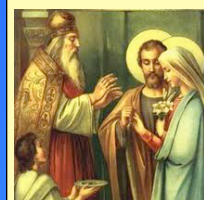
Praying the Rosary in Latin

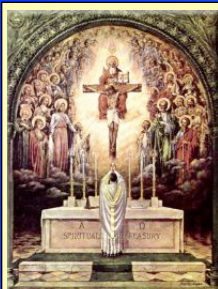


Catholic Marriage

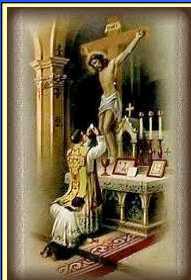


The Most Obvious Differences and Advantages of the Traditional Latin Mass (TLM)

It is exceptionally helpful for those who are unfamiliar with the TLM, yet still provides great benefit to those who have assisted for years, especially in explaining the truth, beauty, and glory of the Traditional Roman Rite.

General Introduction to the Sacraments

David Rodríguez, M.Th.

The spiritual life (sanctifying grace) is fostered and nurtured by the Sacraments, but how well do we understand them? This course provides the fundamental principles of sacramental theology: (1) The definition and nature of a Sacrament. (2) Matter, Form, and Intent. (3) Valid and invalid Sacraments. (3) Church law determines licit and illicit Sacraments. (4) How one can receive the Sacraments more worthily and efficaciously. (5) The same divine *Logos* lies behind Creation, the Incarnation and the Sacraments. The course concludes with a comparative and critical analysis of the new editions of the Catechism and the Code of Canon Law.

The Sacrament of Baptism

This course covers foundational Catholic teaching which every parent and godparent should know prior to baptizing a child. It includes: (1) A scriptural study of Baptism, focusing on Jn 3 and Rom 5-6. (2) Teaching on Baptism from the *Catechism of Trent*. (3) Matter and Form of the Sacrament. (4) Institution of Baptism by Jesus. (5) The role and duties of godparents and how to select them. (6) The necessity of Baptism for salvation. (7) The Church's oft misunderstood teaching on Baptism by Desire. (8) The Church's dogmatic teaching on Limbo. (9) The effects of Baptism. (10) How to baptize in case of a miscarriage.

Marriage and Family

Both the sacred institution of Marriage and the Family are under direct attack today. This course provides an authentically Catholic understanding of Holy Matrimony that is necessary to stem the tide against the vast numbers (even among Catholics) of unmarried partnerships, civil unions, divorces, annulments, and broken families. It explains the scriptural, theological, pastoral and canonical basics of holy Matrimony. It helps dispel many modern errors concerning men and women and provides basic principles for the formation of children, homeschooling and courting. It is an excellent help both to those preparing for marriage and those wishing to strengthen their existing marriage.

The Ten Commandments: Our Duty to God

In order to live upright and truly be good, man must first fulfill his duties towards God, as expressed in Natural Law and the first three Commandments. Basing itself upon the *Catechism of Trent* and several traditional moral textbooks, this class provides a detailed explanation of the first three Commandments, each consisting of: (1) Basic Principles, (2) Positive Precepts, (3) Negative Prohibitions, (4) Mortal Sins, (5) Venial Sins, and (6) numerous helpful examples. Also included under the Third Commandment are the Six Precepts of Holy Mother Church.

The Popes Against Modern Errors

For over two centuries, the Popes consistently and courageously used their holy office to dispel the modern heresies which plagued our world. Their warnings have gone unheeded today, and the same errors they refuted (the 'spirit of diabolical revolution') have seemingly triumphed in every corner of society. Thus, their wise and prophetic words are *even more* pertinent for us today; for in them God had already granted us the antidote against the grave evils afflicting us these days. This course covers over 13 papal encyclicals (from 1830-1950) which are absolutely essential for every Catholic striving to understand the current crisis and desiring to remain faithful to God.

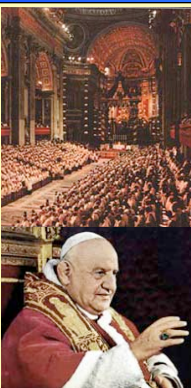


Our Lady of Fatima

The most important event of the 20th century was Our Lady's apparitions at Fatima (1917). There God confirmed her words through the great public Miracle of the Sun. Yet today the Message of Fatima remains largely ignored, misrepresented, and shrouded in confusion. In this course, we study our Lady's apparitions and message, and the chronology of events that have revealed her promises and prophecies to the world. The course addresses how her request for the consecration of Russia remains unfulfilled, the entirety of the Third Secret has yet to be made public, and links the Message of Fatima to the current crisis in the Church and apocalyptic prophecies yet to come.

Understanding the Second Vatican Council

Following the Second Vatican Council (1962-65), the Catholic Church underwent profound changes. Today, the Church finds herself in a grave crisis of Faith and suffering terrible divisions in her unity. In his book, *Pope John's Council*, Michael Davies provides an easy-to-read and poignant analysis of how the historical event of Vatican II was an instrumental cause in the breakdown within the Church. This course follows and supplements that text, highlighting important factors that affected V2, such as: the usurping of the Council by liberal thinkers, the oppressive influence of the media, protestant pressures, and the planting of 'time bombs' within the Council's documents. A remedy to the Church's current crisis can only be found once we understand its nature and acknowledge its roots in Vatican II.

Traditional Catholic Teaching on Religious Liberty

Given the current political and ecclesial climate, it is imperative that each Catholic know the Church's true teaching regarding religious liberty. In this course, one studies magisterial teaching concerning the nature of true freedom and the rights and limits of the individual's freedom of conscience. The ideal Catholic state and the antithesis non-Catholic state are then examined, along with the state's obligations with regards to authentic religious liberty and the social kingship of Jesus Christ. The course concludes by analyzing the factors that led up to the weakening of the Church's traditional teaching at Vatican II and a critical analysis of *Dignitatis Humanæ*, most likely the Council's most controversial document.
